Meeting called to order at 7 p.m. By Sue Ford. Nicole Reisner led us in prayer to open the meeting.

Gregg Swanson, representing the Stewardship Committee, gave us an oversight of what they are about. They began to change the view of stewardship (that is was only about money) to the view that it was and is about time and talent. Treasure is important but that is not the main focus. They did a Stewardship Fair, the Garden of Eden sale, and put information in the Sharing. They are now sponsoring a Called and Gifted Program, the char isms God gives us all, our spiritual side. This means all of us being more aware of our and others talents. The committee did the program first, is offering it to others in a few weeks, and may offer it to the whole parish. It develops char isms as a relationship with Christ; you become aware of your gifts, recognize them, and the use them.

The February minutes were approved as presented.

- Fr. Dennis Martin with Unbound was pleased with the results of his weekend talks. 20 people responded. He will come back in 2-3 years. He does 25-30 presentations a year.

The assessment in 2015 was \$68950 and this year the assessment is \$79000. We are appealing it because it is such a big jump. Amy tried to express our concerns but she couldn't reach the right person (they were on vacation) and it was too late. There was a new account format and it misquoted a bequest for the school. A letter has been sent to Bishop Jenky. The kick-off for ADA is April 9 & 10.
