

BOSCH COMPANY:


 ★ ★ ★ ★ 5 Stars - customer satisfaction!



Expanded reopening

During the last few months, some groups have been meeting outdoors in our shelter. Since cooler weather is approaching, St. Malachy's reopening committee is in the early stages of considering expanding our reopening by setting up some meeting rooms that would have social distancing and could be used for small and medium sized gatherings. Initially, the primary use is to be for official parish groups such as Youth Ministry, CCD, committees, councils, etc. But, perhaps it may also eventually be able to be available to other groups of parishioners by reservation. Any groups meeting would still be required to wear their masks and sanitize the area afterwards with wipes provided. In order to estimate this demand, we are asking that any group that would be interested in this,
