Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

He is Risen. Alleluia! "After this He appeared in another form to two of them walking along on their way to the country. They returned and told the others; but they did not believe them either" (Mark 16:12-13). This Easter Season is

drawing to a close, as we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. This also brings us into the last few weeks of the Year of Missionary Discipleship. It is a fitting time to consider the purpose of everything that we do. 
