## *A Note From the Pastor*



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

He is Risen. Alleluia! *"After this He appeared in another form to two of them walking along on their way to the country. They returned and told the others; but they did not believe them either"* (Mark 16:12-13). This Easter Season is drawing to a close, as we celebrate the **Ascension of the Lord**. This also brings us into the last few weeks of the Year of Missionary Discipleship. It is a fitting time to consider the purpose of everything that we do. We are invited to stand with the Apostles as they watch our Lord return home to the Father and recall how He made His own purpose clear: He came from the Father and was sent to bring us home to Him. However, He desires, not simply to bring us into the physical proximity of our Heavenly Father, but to draw us into His Love. He always remains united in love with the Father, as He told us "I am in the Father and the Father is in Me" (John 14). Out of His intimate knowledge of the Father, He makes Him known to us. And so, as He passes His mission onto us, to make Him more widely known that He may be greatly loved, we can see how the heart of His desire is that we would be *with Him* in living this mission. He desires that we would be with Him and with the Father. Let us, then, set our eyes on Him, seeking first the kingdom of God.

As we turn our eyes together toward the Lord, let us also remember gratefully all who made the Lord known to us. Let us remember all who have made us know that we are loved and helped us to grow into the saints that God made us to become. In particular, let us thank and honor our mothers this weekend, as we celebrate **Mother's Day**. For so many of us, the nurturing love of a mother gives us one of our first experiences of being welcomed into a communion of love, which is an image of the life and love of the Holy Trinity. And yet again this year, Mother's Day overlaps with our **Graduate Mass**, in which we honor and congratulate our young people finishing their high school career. And so let us remember all of our graduates in our prayers that the Lord may lead them into His Holy Will for their lives. And may they make their mothers and fathers proud. With so much to celebrate this weekend at Mass, may we approach the bread of life ready to ENCOUNTER the Risen Christ, so that we may GROW in His grace and truth and GO share the Good News with the world.
