Discussion Notes for Session 2

We talked about what is the "Real Deal" vs. being Scammed. We did this by discussing what is the real purpose of rules? At different stages of life, we saw how rules have changed or adapted with our growth and understanding. We were able to establish that most rules are for our protection. We also talked about what a society without rules would look like and if it could thrive or even survive. Are rules just robbing us of our freedoms or are they protecting us so we can have real freedom?

How does sin rob us from our freedoms? The video speaks of sin in an interesting way. If cursing was your sin, at first it may be no big deal. You just use it every once in a while but then you become more familiar with it and begin using it more till you are suddenly cursing before you even knew it was coming out of your mouth. That simple sin has now taken over and you have lost control and have to focus hard on breaking a bad habit. In fact sin can define us. Telling one lie is not good but if you do it enough people identify you as a liar. The sin can trap you and in a way, rob you of your freedom.

Next we looked at the beginning and took a close look at Adam and Eve's relationship with God and God's plan for them. By not trusting God's plan, Adam and Eve caused a separation from God. We call this Original Sin. Many consequences were as a result of this for all humankind but God didn't leave us abandoned. He sent Jesus to show us the way and repair the separation of Adam and Eve so we can once again be with God completely.
