Any graduating senior who wishes to apply for this scholarship must complete the application which includes a short essay and furnish two references. Completed applications are due **May 1, 2023**.

The scholarship recipient will be selected by a committee consisting of the following:

- Parents Club Officer/Member Representative
- Member of Religious Education or Youth Ministry Program
- Parish Clergy
- Teacher from St. Malachy School
- Teacher from Geneseo High School who is also a member of the St. Malachy Parish Community.

The decision of the above committee will be final. Reception of monies is contingent upon acceptance to an institution of higher learning. The committee has the right to deem the scholarship inappropriate.

Parents Club Scholarship

The purpose of this scholarship is to recognize a graduating senior who has shown exemplary qualities in St. Malachy Parish and the community.

Requirements: The recipient must

- be a member of St. Malachy Parish or attended St. Malachy School
- be a graduating senior.
- have applied to an institution of higher learning.
- be a witness to their Christian faith.
- be involved in the faith community.
