- Parish Clergy
- Teacher from Geneseo High School who is also a member of the St. Malachy Parish Community.

The decision of the above committee will be final. Reception of monies is contingent upon acceptance to an institution of higher learning. The committee has the right to determine that a scholarship will not be awarded.
