





Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,


"The Lord is with you." I trust you recognize those words. The Archangel Gabriel spoke them to Mary in greeting at the beginning of the Gospel of Luke. Now, we say them to her in greeting every time we pray the Hail Mary. We greet her with these words fifty-three times every time we pray the rosary. Have you ever considered Mary as the one who goes before us in all things? The graces

intended for her are meant for us as well. Certainly, we should acknowledge that certain gifts given to her are unique to her. But, even these point toward a grace the Lord wishes to give us. We may not be immaculately conceived, but the Lord does want to give us the grace to be freed from particular sins before we actually fall into them. We may not have the privilege of being the mother of the Lord in the literal sense, but the Lord Himself invoked the figurative image of being His "mother," (Luke 8:21) as He wishes us to carry Him into the world. If this is the case, perhaps we should consider that, when we greet her with these words, the Lord may wish for us to know that He is with us as well. This is part of the beauty of praying the rosary together in groups, such as we just finished doing before weekend Masses throughout October, the Month of the Rosary. We unite with other Christians to share a prayer we have in common. We may hear their voices and maybe even see their faces as a reminder of the Communion we have in the Body of Christ, the Church. We are not alone. The Lord is with us and we can draw near to Him in prayer, as well as remembering our brethren in prayer. In this pandemic that distances us from one another in so many ways, we need to draw near to this Mystery of Communion now more than ever. One effort to address this will take the form of four additional live streams this coming week. This week, we will have a live-stream rosary until we have recorded all four sets of mysteries: Joyful Mysteries on Monday, Sorrowful on Tuesday, Glorious on Wednesday, and Luminous on Thursday. Afterward, the recordings of these rosaries will remain online and be available on DVD for senior living facilities and those not able to utilize online sources. This way, parishioners will be able to pray along with one another in a unique way. I am grateful to Jim Luikart for initiating this idea.


