




Dear St. Malachy Parishioners, Keep Christ in Advent!

Last weekend, in both the homily and the bulletin, I introduced the importance of this concept. If we want to Keep Christ in Christmas, as the slogan fittingly calls us to do, the first step is to keep Him in Advent. This is a practical way of understanding the call that John the Baptist gives to us this weekend: Prepare the way of the Lord. This could include even the recommendation I offered last weekend about gradual decorating. So, if you haven't put up decorations, fear not! You're not behind! In fact, you may have been given an opportunity to experience a beautiful way to enter into Advent. Regardless of how we go about these external preparations, the more important preparation is done within our hearts. How was your time of prayer with the Lord this week? Did you fail to make time to be alone and still with the Lord? Do not worry or become discouraged. Simply resolve to do so today, tomorrow and the day after. Also, remember that part of our spiritual preparation is found in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In addition to the special times at noon Monday through Thursdays, we also have Reconciliation available right after each of the weekend Masses next weekend. I even called in help to make this happen. Fr. Matthew Hoelscher (Chaplain at Alleman High School) will be with us to help hear confessions, give absolution and celebrate the 10:30 Mass. Let's make it worth his drive!

CHRISTMAS MASS SCHEDULE: As we prepare for our annual celebration of Christmas Masses, please be prepared for the difficulty that we could have making room for everyone, given our limited capacity due to the regulations in this time of pandemic. At this point, we are still hopeful to be able to remain in-person for worship by Christmas, although we must remain constantly prepared for all possibilities. Since the 4:00 Mass will pose the greatest challenge regarding space, we anticipate both live-streaming this Mass and opening the overflow seating in the hall. We will not have a sign-up. Regardless, please understand that there does exist the possibility of not having sufficient space at this Mass for everyone who may arrive. Please plan accordingly. Also, please remember that this is only the *first* option.



IN ADDITION TO LAST YEAR'S SCHEDULE, I am offering a final option on Christmas Eve, with the addition of a Mass for this year, at 10:00 PM. This will be what is commonly called the "Midnight Mass." It is very much my hope that our three Mass times on Christmas Eve (4pm, 7pm, and 10pm) and one on Christmas Day (9am) will be able to accommodate all who wish to worship with us in person. Thank you in advance for your flexibility, patience and understanding.

LITURGY LEANINGS DECEMBER 2020



The Liturgical year begins with Advent. Both joyful and repentant, the season prepares us for the coming of Christ as a babe and as a judge at the end of the world. We are asked to prepare, watch, and be ready, a difficult task in this uncertain time. The images of darkness and light parallel the darkening days of December.

- November 29: First Sunday of Advent:
- December 3: St. Francis Xavier: Jesuit and missionary to Asia, patron of missions.
- <u>December 6:</u> Second Sunday of Advent: The voices of Isaiah, St. Peter, and St. Mark call for all of us to prepare for the coming of the Lord!
- December 8: The Immaculate Conception is the patron of the U.S. It is a holy day of Obligation.
- <u>December 12:</u> Our Lady of Guadalupe where Our Lady appears as a mestizo young woman to Juan Diego in 1531. She is the Patron of the Americas.
- <u>December 13:</u> Third Sunday of Advent: Gaudete Sunday is a time of rejoicing, of bearing witness to the coming of our salvation.
- December 14: St. John of the Cross, Priest and Doctor of the Church, Mystic and poet.
- <u>December 20:</u> Fourth Sunday of Advent: As we gather closer to the Nativity, the time of waiting is coming to a close. God's promises made to David in the first reading are fulfilled in the beautiful acceptance of the Blessed Mother told in the Gospel. We are blessed.
- <u>December 25</u>: Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord Christmas, a new liturgical season, finally arrives. The scriptures may differ depending which mass is attended, but the message is the same: In the mystery of the Incarnation our God became human, and the message of his birth was shared with the world. We, too, must carry the light of Christ to all. "Today is born our Savior, Christ the Lord."
- December 26: St. Stephen, First Martyr, and patron of Deacons and altar servers.
- <u>December 27:</u> Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph: "Blessed are those who fear the Lord and walk in His ways."
- December 28: Feast of the Holy Innocents, remembering those innocent children killed by Herod.
 - There are two Feast days that are commonly celebrated that land on a Sunday this year:
- <u>December 6:</u> St. Nicholas, fourth century bishop remembered for his acts of charity, patron of sailors and children.
- <u>December 13:</u> St. Lucy, Virgin and Martyr, whose name means "light" and is celebrated by Scandinavians as a feast of light in the dark winter.




