

#### Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,



"When His parents saw Him, they were astonished and His mother said... 'Your father and I have been looking for you with anxiety." (Luke 2:48). St. Joseph, Foster-father of the Son of God, pray for us! Some of you may have noticed that I neglected to include our monthly verse and title of Saint Joseph in last weekend's bulletin letter. Why, you ask? Because I was writing it on my phone from the backseat of my classmate's car, while still on our vacation. My mind had been removed from parish life for a few days and I offered something brief and "generic" (but, hopefully still enriching) for Divine Mercy Sunday. Now, my head and heart are fully back in parish life and I would like to share how this verse is so closely connected to our Easter focus on the call to share good news of the Resurrection of Jesus in the world, which will be the theme of our parish mission this week. As I said on Easter Sunday, this verse points to the need we all have to REUNITE WITH JESUS. "Each of us should consider the anxious experiences we have had, of being suddenly without Him and ask St. Joseph to pray that we may know the joy and astonishment of being reunited with Him..." If you're reading this, or if you heard me say it on Easter Sunday, you probably have already begun to reunite with Him. Praise God! Here's a sobering fact that might put things into perspective, though. If you heard or read these words, either because you have returned to Mass in person or have been faithfully remaining engaged remotely amidst the pandemic, statistically, you are in the minority. Let that sink in for a moment. Many of our brothers and sisters are still out there, unengaged, isolated and disconnected. They are our family. How will they Reunite With Jesus? Is there a plan? Yes, there is. YOU. You are that plan. The Hope the world needs has been placed within you. It must be shared. You must reach out and offer that Hope to our brothers and sisters. Go get them and welcome them home. For some, this coming home will mean returning to Mass in person very soon, while for others it will mean being engaged in other ways to reconnect with their parish family, until they judge that this in-person return is safe and appropriate for them. We must be extending the invitation to this return home, whatever form it takes for each person. Reach out to someone you haven't seen or heard from in awhile, greet them as a brother or sister, with encouragement, support, and friendship and without judgement or presumption. The Holy Spirit just may start the process for you. He may place someone on your heart or work it out that you would run across one another in the near future. "Always be ready," as Saint Peter says (1 Peter 3:15). I look forward to breaking open this simple but beautiful verse from Saint Peter with you, throughout the mission, because it is part of how you can help your brothers and sisters to reunite with Jesus and to realize that He came forth from the tomb to meet them!


