

A Note From the Pastor ...

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Joseph... took (Mary) his wife into his home." (Matthew 1:24b). Saint Joseph, Spouse of the Mother of God, Chaste Guardian of the Virgin, pray for us! Last weekend, I preached* on how Saint Joseph is praying for all of us to be able to take Mary into our homes, into our hearts, especially in this Month of Mary. In the process, I shared a bit of my own journey of growing to realize that I could trust that Mary would not take any focus away from Christ, but only wanted to lead me closer to Him. Since then, I have had a handful of interesting conversations with others who have shared that they have been on, or are still on, a similar journey of deepening trust in Our Lady, even to the point of growing to love her. But, how does one take steps along this journey? As I shared, it was when I began to *experience* this relationship with Mary leading me closer to Christ, that I began to believe that what I had heard - namely that devotion to Mary is truly centered on Jesus Christ. So, what might be some of the steps along the journey, which might help someone begin to experience this? I will identify five steps, which need not be taken in any particular order:

1. Begin praying the rosary regularly. Find a method that works for you. Some people find the rhythm of the prayers helpful in drawing them into prayer, like the gentle rocking of a boat, bringing a sailor into sync with the movement of the sea. Still, others find this rhythm difficult to enter into and are more easily drawn into the mysteries by praying one decade at a time, perhaps even focusing on one mystery at a time, for a given day or a given time of prayer. It is okay to spread out your rosary over five days, but I recommend finishing each one you start.

Read the Scriptures associated with each mystery of the Rosary. You might do this while praying the rosary, as one does when praying a "Scriptural Rosary." But, you can also do this in your own time, either before or after praying the rosary. You can even make a twenty-day plan, spending some time praying with the Scriptures behind the mysteries from beginning to end, from the First Joyful Mystery (Annunciation) all the way to the Fifth Glorious Mystery (Coronation of Mary). Spending time praying with these Scriptures will enhance your experience, when you pray your rosary, of letting Mary take you by the hand & lead you into the mysteries of Christ's Life, Death, & Resurrection.
 Read spiritual reading from Catholic authors who share their own experience of coming

to know the heart of Mary and to know her as a model of living in the love of the Lord. I mentioned one example last week, in Caryll Houselander's *The Reed of God*. Other examples would be Ven. Fulton Sheen's *The World's First Love* and Fr. Michael Gaitely's 33 Days to Morning Glory.

4. Do some more informative Marian study, in order to understand how important is the role of Mary within God's plan, as revealed in Scripture. Two examples of studies come to

mind that are very enlightening in showing just how Biblical true devotion to Mary really is! The first is *The Bible and the Blessed Virgin Mary*, which is a video study based on the book *Hail, Holy Queen* by Scott Hahn. The other is *Lectio: Mary*, which is another video study based on the book *Jesus and the Jewish Roots of Mary* by Brant Pitre.


5. Lastly, learn about the four basic Marian Dogmas. Fill your toolbelt with a proper understanding of what the Church actually believes and teaches about Mary, so as to break through all of the confusion and wrong understandings. As you learn them, you will see how everything we believe about Mary hinges on a proper understanding of who Jesus is! For example, the Early Church Fathers understand that the only way to deny that Mary is the Mother of God would be to deny or distort the full and glorious mystery of the Incarnation of Jesus! A recommended source for this study, and many other questions, would be Catholic Answers, which does great work to help Catholics better understand our faith, even to the point of being able to explain and defend it to others.
