

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,



Friends, let's pause and appreciate something. As of this weekend, Saint Malachy has been able to return to Mass for a year! Of course, the irony is that, at the start of 2020, if someone had told us this was a big deal, we might have thought that was a strange thing to say. Yet, after enduring months when it was not possible to attend Mass, we hopefully have come out of it with a deeper appreciation of the gift of the Mass, along with so many other gifts that we might have once taken for granted, until we suddenly found ourselves with it. So, first, in the spirit of gratefully appreciating where we are now and what we have, let us consider how far we've come. Over the course of the past year, I have used words like 'ongoing' and even 'gradual' to describe the reopening process. At times, the process seemed to be moving slowly, or even stalled or even taking temporary steps backwards. At other times, we have gratefully embraced those steps forward that people have sometimes described as "little doses of normal." Last weekend, we had the first round of Masses in which masks were not required at any time (the only exception being those who are *distributing* Holy Communion, and even that requirement will not last forever). You may recall that the mask mandates were already in place when I came to Saint Malachy. For many parishioners, I am just now seeing your faces for the first time. It is a joy to see your beautiful smiles and return my own smile. It makes me think of the appreciation Mother Teresa had of the value of a smile, as a way to satisfy the thirst of Christ, alive in those around us who hunger and thirst to know that they are loved, valued, appreciated, and even rejoiced in! This prompts me, next, to invite us all to consider one other important thing that we can be tempted to take for granted: the people in our life. Consider that there might be someone in your life who does not feel that they have anyone in their life... but they have you. Do they know that they are loved, valued, appreciated, and even rejoiced in? Perhaps you can take a moment this week, maybe even today, to show them. Finally, another thing Mother Teresa would tell us is that this starts at home. May all families grow to appreciate one another more deeply and may they have the prayers and support of their parish family. *Saint Joseph, Head of the Holy Family, Pillar of Families, and Glory of Domestic Life, pray for us!*
