This weekend, my mind goes to the Revival Retreat which has been taking place for our



high school teens this weekend. The retreat was prompted by the fact that it was too soon to know yet whether a trip to a Steubenville Youth Conference would be possible, by the time we would have had to register. This would mean the second consecutive year in which this long standing tradition would have to be canceled. Always seeking creative solutions to not allow obstacles to prevent us from doing anything, the idea arose to do something locally and invite some of our seniors, who missed out on their last chance to go to another of these conferences in high school, to help us plan it. So, this spring, Darci Dietrich and I began guiding these seniors through the process of discerning what the retreat should consist of. From their own hearts, arose this desire to focus on Revival, with the inspiration of the theme verse, which they chose: "So whoever is in Christ is a new creation: the old things have passed away; behold, new things have come." (2 Corinthians 5:17). They also chose Saint Mary Magdalene and Saint Joseph as the patron saints for the retreat. Taking these various elements and combining them with the Scripture readings the Lord would be speaking to our hearts in Mass that weekend, I put the pieces together into a novena we could do to help us prepare for the weekend. On a whim, I mentioned this novena to those present at daily Mass on Thursday night, simply inviting them to join us in using the novena as a way to pray for the teens on the retreat. I knew we had many Prayer Warriors at Mass, but I wasn't completely ready for the degree of generous response to this simple request for prayers: we ran out of copies and had to send people into the office to make more, for which people stuck around and waited! This readiness to pray, regardless of whether or not the retreat was "for them" was such an encouraging reminder of the fact that no group within our parish, whether it be Oasis or one of our adult prayer groups or whatever, is an isolated silo. All are a part of the larger parish family, which supports all of its members! Let us pray that the youth on the retreat may be open to receive the graces the Lord wishes to give them. But then, may they also bring those graces back home, so as to bring that Revival, which only the Lord can bring, to their families and to our parish family!

"Jesus went down with (Mary and Joseph) and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them..." (Luke 2:51).
