

A Note From the Pastor .

"Is He not the carpenter's son?" (Matthew 13:55). Saint Joseph, Foster-Father of the Son of God, Zealous Defender of Christ, Model of Workmen, pray for us! In work and in rest, Christ wants to be a part of our lives. It is amazing to consider that the same God who made the heavens and the earth, who led His people through the Red Sea, sustained them in the desert and continually led them through generations of trial and triumph, entered into the home of a poor, humble carpenter. He also wants to enter your life and mine. May our hearts be open to receive Him more deeply into our lives today.

Where in the world is Father Gifford this week?: As mentioned last weekend, I am beginning a two-week period away for the summer, but it's not all vacation. This weekend, I am away for a wedding that I have been committed to for some time, back in Princeton. I will also be visiting some family while in the area and then I leave for my last year of Junior Clergy Days, for the remainder of the week. 
