Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,



"Is He not the carpenter's son?" (Matthew 13:55). Saint Joseph, Foster-Father of the Son of God, Zealous Defender of Christ, Model of Workmen, pray for us! One of the things that amazes me about this month's theme verse is that the statement is true, yet there is so much more to this Simple Carpenter than meets the eye! First, let's consider how the statement is true. Throughout this Year of Saint Joseph, I've made my case a few times already that the title "Foster-Father of the Son of God" is a bit of an understatement. He may not have been the biological father (for there is not one), but Joseph was no less an authentic human father, as any adoptive father is to his children Joseph lived out this vocation faithfully and fervently as the "Zealous Defender of Christ." And like many fathers, he taught his trade to his son, as the "Model of Workmen." So, indeed, in this sense, Jesus truly is the carpenter's son. Yet, He is so much more. He is the Beloved Son of the Heavenly Father, the Son of God, the Second Person of the Holy Trinity. Simply put, He is truly God. Yet, He is also truly the carpenter's son. This is part of the mystery of the Incarnation of God, not simply that if you did a DNA test you would find His biology to be fully human (and indeed, such a test would reveal no biological trace of Joseph), but that He lived a human life. He truly was the carpenter's son. But, He was so much more. How often do we judge by appearance? Do we see the beautiful image of God in the people that we meet? Do we recall His words, when He told us that we would meet Him, when we meet the least in the kingdom? Let us pray for the eyes of faith, to see and honor the image of God in every human soul.

Where in the world is Father Gifford this week?: Now that my final Junior Clergy Days retreat is over, I am now taking a week of vacation, before returning to be full steam ahead in preparing for a new academic year with you all. Essentially, the vacation portion of my time away consists of two smaller trips: a few days visiting family in Virginia Beach and a few days visiting some of my classmates and friends from seminary in Michigan. At least one of these trips was originally planned to take place last year, before the whole world basically shut down. Thanks be to God for new beginnings. See you all next weekend.


