Liturgy Leanings



We are continuing Ordinary Time into August with the 18th Sunday. Ordinary Time will end with the 34th Sunday on November 22. It comes from the Latin word Ordo, which means order in English and is the period of watchfulness and expectation for the second coming of Christ.

Some of the feast days during August are:

8/4 St. John Vianney - known as the Cure' of Ars.

8/6 Feast of the Transfiguration - when Jesus is changed in the presence of Peter, James, and John which highlights Jesus' divinity and glory.

8/14 St. Maximilian Kolbe - priest who offered himself as a substitute to save the life of a young father by their Nazi captors. **8/15 Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary -** At her death, God assumed her bodily into heaven where she now enjoys full union with her Lord.

8/21 St. Pius X - Pope Pius reformed the liturgy, promoted the Gregorian Chant, and lowered the age of first Communion, from 12 to 7 years.

8/28 St. Augustine - Bishop & Doctor of the Church, he was a theologian and philosopher. He died on 8/28/430 AD. From Hippo, North Africa, St. Augustine reminds us that God never gives up on us, even if at times we give up on ourselves or give up on him.

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Each year His parents went to Jerusalem for the feast of Passover..." (Luke 2:41). Saint Joseph, Most Faithful, pray for us! As I introduced last week, this evidence of the Holy Family's commitment to the Passover will help us to reflect on our own devotion to the fulfillment of the Passover, in the Holy Eucharist, which is the theme of our Gospel this week and much of this month. As we consider this aspect of the faithfulness of the Holy Family, reinforced further by our title of focus for the month of August, "Joseph Most Faithful," we should consider where it is that all believers find the strength to be faithful. Our faithfulness is merely an imitation of and response to the Lord's faithfulness. As our lives continue to be marked by a great deal of uncertainty, particularly regarding the spread of the new "Delta variant" of Covid-19, it is now especially important to remember the faithfulness of the Lord. Consider how the Lord has revealed His faithfulness to you. This is one of the reasons why God's people have always passed down these stories, first by word of mouth and later in writing. (Including those writings that we know today as Sacred Scripture) to help us remember. There are many lessons the Lord has taught His people through the years, including those simple reminders of His faithfulness. These lessons need to be remembered and called to mind, and they often are hardest to pull up from memory during those times when the pressures weighing upon us are greatest. So, the stories need to be constantly shared, as time goes on. As each generation endures its own hardship, it is most common to hope that the next generation can learn from them what they had to learn the hard way. So, they passed down those stories of how they learned these lessons. We need to learn from that example. When the Lord reveals His faithfulness to you, even in some small way, follow these five steps:

- 1) Stop: Take some time of stillness, either right in the moment or at least before bed that night.
- 2) Thank the Lord in prayer.
- 3) Tell someone: Find at least one person with whom you can share this blessing, both as an encouragement and witness to them and as a way of reinforcing its significance in your own memory and consciousness.
- 4) Write it down: Maybe you keep a journal. Maybe you just write it on a napkin. Maybe you could enter it into your calendar, and if it's a digital calendar, you might even be able to program in a reminder when the date comes back around next year. Maybe you can enter it into a social media post (Pro-tip: this is another great way to share it with others, but don't let that stop you from sharing it in person!).
- 5) Say another prayer, asking the Lord to help you remember this when it becomes most difficult to trust Him.

For today, consider taking some time to write down at least three times in your life in which God has revealed His faithfulness to you. Then, make sure you don't lose that list! Remember. And let His faithfulness inspire your own faithfulness to Him in return.

Beginning Another School Year: When I think of the fact that our school resumes before the end of this week, I recall the many blessings of last year. Journeying through a year filled with uncertainty and challenges together with our students, faculty, staff, and families, as the Lord revealed His faithfulness in so many ways, was truly a great highlight of my first year with you all. Providentially, it just so happened that I arrived at Saint Malachy in the week of the Feast of Saint Padre Pio. This meant that the very first lesson I was able to share with our school at School Mass focused on his wise and simple words: *Pray, Hope and Don't Worry*.



Throughout the year, these words seemed to reverberate back to me, as they resonated in the hearts of the children, as well as the adults. Whether you are a student at Saint Malachy School or not, may these words carry us you through another year certain to be filled with more new reminders of the faithfulness of the Lord.


