

Permanent Diaconate News:



As you know, our parish is blessed to have two candidates for the Permanent Diaconate. Tom Mattan and his wife, Debbie, and Bob Thoene and his wife, Shauna, have been attending formation weekends once a month, ten months a year for four and a half years now.

The next formal step on the road to Ordination in the Permanent Diaconate will take place on Sunday, August 22, 2021 at a 10:30 am Mass at the Sacre-Coeur Retreat Center. On that day Bishop Tylka will institute Tom and Bob and their classmates in the Ministry of Acolyte.

An Acolyte is appointed to attend to the service of the altar. Thus he assists the Deacon and the Priest at liturgical celebrations, distributes Holy Communion and instructs others who are to assist at liturgical celebrations.

The commitment that Tom and Bob have made to pursue this training and to prepare to serve all the people of our parish is significant. We look forward to the day when Tom and Bob share the graces of the Sacrament of Holy Orders, and when the Mattans and Thoenes know, in even deeper ways, the joys of following Christ's call in their lives. We encourage everyone to support them with your prayers.

A Note From the Pastor


Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Each year His parents (Mary and Joseph) went to Jerusalem for the feast of Passover..." (Luke 2:41). Saint Joseph, Most Faithful, pray for us! Like many of the verses in which Saint Joseph features, this month's theme verse features our mother Mary just as prominently. This weekend, as we celebrate the Feast of the Assumption of Mary, it is good that we direct our focus more to the example of our Blessed Mother. So, let's consider the significance of Our Lady's example of faithfulness to the Passover, that celebration within the old covenant that so profoundly prefigured the Holy Eucharist. Mary does indeed want to teach us faithfulness and devotion to the Holy Eucharist. What did Mary experience, upon her yes to the angel? Jesus Christ, the Son of the Living God, came to truly dwell within her. What do we experience, upon our "Amen," to receive the Holy Eucharist? Jesus Christ, the Son of the Living God, comes to truly dwell within us. This should move our hearts to deep humility. How can we possibly receive such a gift? There is no one better to address this question than Our Lady, who understands it profoundly, because she experienced it first. May Our Lady pray for each and every one of us, that we approach the Lord with great humility, devotion and faithfulness in the Holy Eucharist.
