
If you are receiving envelopes and are not using them, please let us know and we will cancel the mailing. Please consider online giving. Go to our website or call the office to do so.





A Note From the Pastor

"Christian, remember your dignity!" Pope Saint Leo the Great, one of the great saints to occupy the Chair of Peter, is remembered fondly for this beautiful exhortation. "Christian, remember your dignity, and now that you share in God's own nature, do not return by sin to your former base condition. Bear in mind who is your head and of whose body you are a member. Do not forget that you have been rescued from the power of darkness and brought into the light of God's kingdom. Through the sacrament of baptism, you have become a temple of the Holy Spirit. Do not drive away so great a guest by evil conduct and become again a slave to the devil, for your liberty was bought by the blood of Christ." As we began discussing last week. Saint Joseph offers us all a witness to how even royal dignity can coexist with poverty and humility. Do you recognize the royal blood of the King coursing through your veins? Ask that poor humble carpenter from Nazareth with royal blood coursing through his veins to pray for you, that you may embrace this dignity with a profound awe and wonder, that is manifest in deep humility, as well as unwavering faithfulness to the Lord. "And Joseph too went up from Galilee from the town of Nazareth to Judea, to the city of David that is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and family of David ... " (Luke 2:4). Saint Joseph, Noble Offspring of David, Light of Patriarchs, pray for us!


