

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her..." (Matthew 1:20(b)). What a truly awesome calling it is to be a mother or a father! This Respect Life Month, let us ask Saint Joseph and our Blessed Mother, both to intercede for those who feel overwhelmed, fearful or unprepared when this calling comes unexpectedly, and also to move all of our hearts to greater compassion for them. May the expectant parents in that situation have the grace to trust in the Holy Spirit. And may we allow ourselves to be moved by the same Spirit to assist where we can, in order to help meet the needs of these parents and their children. Last week, as Our Lord was pointing us toward the beauty of God's plan for marriage and subtly indicated its intimate connection to children, it was a fitting time to begin reflecting upon Joseph's own call to take his wife into his home and thus also to accept the Christ Child as his adopted son. While the situation of the Holy Family might have been quite different from that of many others who find themselves suddenly facing an unexpected pregnancy, still both must learn what it means to trust in the Holy Spirit.

When I was planning our monthly illustration of the theme version (see picture), I wanted to illustrate the presence of the Holy Spirit as much as possible. As you may know, one of the most prominent images used for the Holy Spirit is that of a dove. As I considered this, my memory turned toward the three little birds (notice the "three," hinting at the Holy Trinity) at the base of our Saint Francis statue, out in the prayer garden. Francis is a wonderful example for us of being open to recognizing how all of the creatures we meet in God's creation point us toward the glory of their Creator. This is why we hear so much of his love for animals, because all of creation pointed him toward the One he loved most: Our God, the Creator of all! Thus, we offered a special pet blessing on his feast day, which was celebrated this past week. Meanwhile, as well as these other reasons I was drawn to this picture, both because of the image of the birds and the feast of Saint Francis at the beginning of the month, I also was



struck by the fact that I must have taken the picture last fall - the lighting and colors of the leaves on the ground scream October! Lastly, with so many colors at play in the picture only one color seemed readable, when used for the text: red, the color of the Holy Spirit.

This can serve as a reminder for all of us to keep our eyes open, to recognize God's glory and the reminders of His goodness and faithfulness, in the world around us - such as being reminded of the Holy Spirit by the sight or the song of birds. When we have our eyes open in this way, we realize how much we have for which to be thankful. Thus, we should consider the second phrase that we learned as children, which can teach us to **pray with the faith of a child: Thank You**. God is so good to us. Do not take His gifts for granted. Stop and notice them. Name them. Thank Him. We can easily become consumed with what we think we want or need, what we have asked for, how we asked for it and with what timetable. Having the humility to recognize that God knows better

than we do begins with stopping to notice the abundant gifts He has bestowed on us, whether we asked for them or not. We also sometimes have to endure hardship that is so great that it can be very hard to see beyond it. Even if these challenges do not immediately go away, the Lord is offering us compassion, by helping us see that He is with us through it all. This compassion will be the source of the strength, patience, and endurance that we need. Stopping to recognize and thank Him for the gifts we can recognize helps us begin to discover that He is indeed with us and to receive this compassion and strength.

May Saint Joseph pray for us, that we may learn to trust in the Holy Spirit's guidance and assistance as we seek to live out the vocation to which He has called us. *Saint Joseph, Most Courageous, Spouse of the Mother of God, pray for us!*


