





A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

Wow, what a weekend we had last week! First, we had a blessed Feast Day Celebration at both the Holy Mass and the receptions after both Masses on Sundays. The Mass was a genuinely felt experience of God's love alive in our parish, as well a reminder of His abiding presence through the years, while the receptions provided an opportunity to continue to celebrate this gift gratefully, within a more social setting. A big thank you to Altar and Rosary for this reception, as well as the children for contributing their artwork and the teachers who helped make this happen! Second, we had many of our school parents working hard to pull off a "Take N' Bake" option for the Lasagna Supper, with remarkable success. Finally, we had many of our parishioners involved with the JPII Experience retreat in Moline and I am still continuing to hear the graces from grateful hearts of youth who encountered Christ, parents rejoicing in this gift for their children and also adult team members who saw His Love moving and active in powerful ways. During the homily, I spoke about moments that do a shepherd's heart good. An example of such moments could be found in the weekend itself and the novena days which preceded it.

I also spoke about the connection between shepherds and fathers, as fathers are called to shepherd their families. That connection also goes the other way: shepherds too are called to be spiritual fathers. I found it ironic that between JPII Experience, Oasis (High School Youth Ministry) and The Rock (Junior High Youth Ministry), I had the opportunity to speak about vocations and discernment to three different groups of young people in the final days leading up to the feast day. Once the feast day arrived, we read a Gospel which ended in the words "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few. So


ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." You all must have heeded our Lord's words and asked the Master to send out laborers for His harvest, because He answered those prayers by sending me into the fields to plant some seeds.

There are few things that fuel my spiritual fatherhood more than looking young people in the eye and paying forward the important truth that was told to me: God loves you and has a plan for your life and that plan is the best plan for your happiness. When I was their age, I would never have guessed that this plan included coming to Geneseo to be a spiritual father to this parish family. It just goes to show that the truly best plan for our happiness is something we could not dream up on our own.

As our hearts are filled with gratitude and affection for our parish family, may Saint Joseph continue to watch over all of our children, that they may be shepherded into God's glorious plan for their lives. "Joseph rose and took the child and his mother by night and departed for Egypt." (Matthew 2:14). Saint Joseph, Noble Offspring of David, Light of Patriarchs, Zealous Defender of Christ, pray for us!


Prayer and Pilgrimage with Fulton Sheen
