



A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

Advent 2021:

A Time of Safe Refuge to Remember the Faithfulness of God

As I mentioned last week, this theme I have proposed for us flows out of the November theme verse for the Year of Saint Joseph: "When they had departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, 'Rise, take the child and his mother, flee to Egypt, and stay there until I tell you. Herod is going to search for the child to destroy him.' Joseph rose and took the child and his mother by night and departed for Egypt." (Matthew 2:13-14). Just as Saint Joseph was led to lead the Holy Family to a place of safe refuge, when a great threat was upon them, so also we must seek safe refuge with the Lord, in the midst of whatever trials we might endure. We also found a reflection of this in Revelation 12. in which the Woman is taken to a place of safe refuge, as the dragon pursues her, seeking to devour her Child, while the Lord sends Michael and his army to fight the battle. What is pursuing you, seeking to rob you of your peace and distract you from doing the Lord's Will in your life? Rather than trying to fight that battle for yourself, recognize that the Lord is fighting for you. Accept His invitation to find safe refuge in Him and remember His faithfulness.

Since we will be in December later this week, allow me also to introduce our next and final monthly theme verse for this Year of Joseph and explain how it relates to our theme. "... Jacob the father of Joseph, the husband of Mary. Of her was born Jesus who is called the Messiah... behold, the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, 'Joseph, son of David..." (Matthew 1:16,20). Who doesn't love genealogies, right?! Part of the beauty of concluding the Year of Joseph with the conclusion of the genealogy of Christ is not only that it shows Joseph as a part of that genealogy, but it shows the faithfulness of God through the ages. Furthermore, it allows us to see the continuity between the Old Testament and the New, as God continually revealed Himself to us and taught us to trust in His faithfulness. It is fitting for Advent to enter into this spirit of the Old Covenant: awaiting God's


Promise, to be fulfilled in the coming of Jesus Christ, as we allow God to work in our lives and teach us to trust in His faithfulness through the years.

Saint Joseph, Noble Offspring of David, Light of Patriarchs, pray for us!

Conclusion of the Year of Saint Joseph: It can be confusing that we use the word "year" in so many different ways. Of course, we have the secular calendar year, which begins in January and runs through the end of December. Then, we have the Church Year, which begins with the First Sunday of Advent and ends with Christ the King (in addition to the weekdays that follow). Also, we casually often refer to the academic year as "the year," as we usually begin many new programs for all ages in the fall in sync with the start of school for the children. When I have referred to "Follow Jesus with the Faith of a Child" as the spiritual theme for "the year." I have meant it in this sense of the academic year. So, what about this Year of Joseph we have heard so much about? Well, when the Pope declares a special "year" such as this one, he can sort of begin and end it whenever he wants and usually picks a significant date to do so. This one began on December 8 (Immaculate Conception), 2020 ends on December 8, 2021. So, it began and ends with a feast of his beloved spouse, Our Blessed Mother Mary. Let us spend these final days of the Year of Saint Joseph, asking both of their assistance in remaining devoted to Jesus Christ and following Him with the faith of a child.

Liturgy Leanings - December: Advent/Christmas Cycle C Readings

The Liturgical year begins with Advent, November 28. Both joyful and repentant, the season prepares us for the coming of Christ as a babe and as a judge at the end of the world. We are asked to prepare, watch, and be ready, a difficult task in this uncertain time.

November 28: First Sunday of Advent: We lift our souls to the Lord.

December 3: St. Francis Xavier: Jesuit and missionary to Asia, patron of missions.

December 5: Second Sunday of Advent: ...all flesh shall see the salvation of our God.

December 6: St. Nicholas, fourth century bishop remembered for his acts of charity, patron of sailors and children.

December 8: The Immaculate Conception is the patron of the U.S. It is a holy day of Obligation.

December 9: St. Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin, who saw Our Lady of Guadalupe.

December 12: Third Sunday of Advent: Gaudete Sunday is a time of rejoicing, of bearing witness to the coming of our salvation.

December 13: St. Lucy, Virgin and Martyr, whose name means "light" and is celebrated by Scandinavians as a feast of light in the dark winter.

December 14: St. John of the Cross, Priest and Doctor of the Church, Mystic and poet.

December 19: Fourth Sunday of Advent: As we gather closer to the Nativity, the time of waiting is coming to a close. ...let us see Your face, and we shall be saved.

December 25: Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord Christmas, a new liturgical season, finally arrives. The scriptures may differ depending which Mass is attended, but the message is the same: In the mystery of the Incarnation our God became human, and the message of his birth was shared with the world. We, too, must carry the light of Christ to all. "Today is born our Savior, Christ the Lord,"

December 26: Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph: "Blessed are those who fear the Lord and walk in His wavs."

December 27: St. John the Apostle and Evangelist

December 28: Feast of the Holy Innocents, remembering those innocent children killed by Herod.

A Feast Day that is commonly celebrated but lands on a Sunday this year:

December 12: Our Lady of Guadalupe where Our Lady appears as a mestizo young woman to Juan Diego in 1531. She is the Patron of the Americas.


