

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

Eucharist means thanksgiving. As Catholics, this is one of those simple teachings that many of us grow up being taught and remembering through the years. As we celebrate First Communion this weekend, those words are on my mind.

Next, I gratefully recall last weekend's Car Party. This was



### Prayer for Peace in the Ukraine


O Prince of Peace, once more we hear the guns of war, once more we see the faces of frightened children.
