*R./: "I will praise your name forever, my King and my God."* 


## 2nd Reading: Revelation 21:1-5a

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners

Savor His Love and celebrate it with joy as you follow Jesus with the Faith of a Child! Since we are to follow Jesus with the faith of a child, I'd like to begin with the example of some of our children. Last year, in my first year at our school, I shared a different quote either from Scripture, from a saint or inspired by one of the above. I would frequently review them with the students at the Wednesday morning School Mass. One of the quotes which they remembered most readily was the words that Jesus said to Saint John and to all beloved disciples from the cross: Behold your mother. On this Mother's Day weekend and in this month of Mary, these are words we all should consider and take to heart.

First, have we embraced Marv as our spiritual mother? Have we come to know personally that she will never take the place of Christ, as some fear, but will only help us grow closer to Him? If not, have we tried? Do we pray the rosary? We should remember that the rosary is not simply a long repetitive litany of prayers. When we really ask her to help us reflect deeply on the Joyful, Sorrowful, Luminous and Glorious Mysteries, we discover this ancient prayer as a way of allowing Mary to take us by the hand (notice that we hold a symbol and instrument of our prayer in our hands) and walk us into the Scriptures, into the events of Our Lord's Life, Death and Resurrection, so that we may truly meet Jesus there... at the manger, in the Temple, at the Wedding feast, at the Cross, outside the Empty Tomb, and in the Upper Room. On a related note, praying with the Scriptures in which Mary appears (grab a guide to the mysteries of the Rosary and it will point them out to you) is a great way to get to know her personally as the mother who nourishes the gift of Divine Life within you.

Last, but never least, how are you honoring your own mother today? If she is living, are you doing something to show your gratitude, respect and love? If she is not, offer some prayers for her and do something that would truly honor her. On this day, it is also worth remembering to offer prayers and support for those who have lost or have a difficult relationship with their mothers. We also might think of those in our lives who have been spiritual mothers or motherly figures to us. Motherhood is indeed a great gift, which we are reminded this weekend not to take for granted. We might even consider how the Scriptural view (especially Genesis 2:24) reminds us that one of the ways we honor our mothers is by how we live our lives, as we go forward living our own vocation. On that note...

GRADUATE MASS: Next week, we will honor our graduates at the 10:30 Mass. Each year, it is always an emotional experience, as we send off another group of our young people, whom we have sought to nourish and support in their faith, in our homes, our parish, our school, our CCD program, sacramental prep and youth ministry. It is with great confidence that we entrust them to the Holy Spirit, who will continue to lead them and guide them. And of course, we look forward to continuing to see them and being a part of their journey when they are home for breaks. The Lord does indeed have big plans for them (as an example, this past week, we heard from one of last year's seniors on Thursday Thoughts), so please join me in praying for them, especially as we honor them at our annual Graduate Mass, the week before their graduation. A reception will take place after the 10:30 Mass (as well as a Coffee and Donuts after the 8:15 Mass).



Recommendation forms will be available to submit online through the St. Malachy's website or by paper in the Narthex until Sunday, May 15th. Then, an informational orientation meeting will be held in late May/early June with the parish members who have been recommended and who are interested in serving on the council and the members of the selection committee, which consists of two members from the council and two non-council Parish members. After the orientation, those interested will provide some biographical information to the selection committee, who will meet to discern, pray, and select the new members of the council. The new member recommendations will be presented to Father Gifford for approval and then announced to the parish in June. These new members will start their 3-year term in July.
