A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

When we allow our encounter with Christ in the Eucharist to become truly the source, summit, and center of our lives, we begin to know and live what it means to live in God's presence! When I made that statement last week, I was primarily referring to the Sunday Mass. However, one way that we can deepen our Eucharistic devotion is by attending Daily Mass, when we have the opportunity.

At Saint Malachy, we begin every week with three consecutive (M-W) days of morning Mass at 8 AM. On Thursday (the birthday of the Eucharist), we move Mass to the evening (5:45 PM), making it more accessible to many who work during the day, and we prepare for this special evening Mass with a Holy Hour of Eucharistic Adoration (4:30 PM) and Reconciliation (5 PM). Normally, Friday is the only day in which we do not have Mass, but only an 8 AM Communion Service offered by one of our deacons.

However, once a month, we have a First Friday Mass at 8 AM, followed by a "Holy Half-Hour" of Eucharistic Adoration, including the praying of a Divine Mercy Chaplet. If you're not familiar with the chaplet, it's very easy to follow along with and it's a great prayer to learn! This First Friday devotion is inspired by the revelations of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque and thus is offered especially in honor of the Sacred Heart. We welcome you to join us this coming Friday to "*Behold the Heart which has so loved man.*" Additionally, we have a First Saturday Mass at 8 AM, which is also normally followed by a "Holy Half-Hour" of Eucharistic Adoration, including the praying of a Rosary. Naturally, the First Saturday devotion is offered in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Just as the beloved disciple (St. John) spent that first Holy Saturday with Our Lady, after our Lord commanded him

from the cross, "Behold your Mother," so also all beloved disciples of Our Lord are encouraged to set aside Saturdays as a day especially spent with her.

In July, our First Saturday Mass happens to be on the 32nd Anniversary of the dedication of the current Saint Malachy Church (July 2). Unbeknownst to many, the anniversary of the dedication of the parish church is actually a date on which the Church calls us to celebrate with greater solemnity. This may seem odd, until we stop and think about the importance of celebrating the inheritance of our faith, handed down to us through the generations and the witness of God's faithfulness found in each passing generation. This is indeed an occasion to celebrate. Thus, we will start with adoration and the rosary at 7:30 AM, followed by a special 8 AM Mass, followed by a light breakfast reception for all present.

Let us embrace every opportunity to *enter more deeply into the way of life of a disciple of Jesus Christ: a life lived in God's presence!*

My Absence The First Two Weeks of July: This is just a reminder that I mentioned earlier in the summer that I will be gone the first two weeks of July. This will be a mix of a small bit of personal time away, my annual retreat, and then "back to work" when I meet our youth at the Steubenville Youth Conference. I will be leaving after the 10:30 Mass next Sunday (July 3). There will be a few days of Communion Services (July 4-6), until our visiting SMA (Society of African Missions) Priest arrives. He will be with us until July 19.

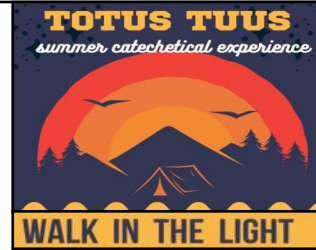
