



A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

One of the things about the Lord's presence is that... it's everywhere. In the beautiful Psalm 139, the psalmist reflects on how the God who probes us and knows us, knows when we sit and we stand, who understands our thoughts from afar, who formed our innermost being and knit us in our mother's womb... He's everywhere. "From your presence, where can I flee? If I ascend to the heavens, you are there; if I lie down in Sheol, there you are. If I take the wings of dawn and dwell beyond the sea, even there your hand guides me, your right hand holds me fast." The Lord certainly reminded me of this during my two weeks away from the parish. Please don't misunderstand, by taking me too literally. Priests don't take time away from the parish, in order to avoid the Lord's presence, nor do we expect to be able to do so. One of many phrases drilled into us in seminary is: There's no vacation from vocation. In fact, I have shared before that I often try to approach my vacations as pilgrimages and encourage this practice for everyone.

Even in this time away, which wasn't quite vacation, but a mix of time with family, my annual priestly retreat and finally the Steubenville Youth Conference, I was amazed at how the Lord reminded me of His constant presence throughout this diverse set of experiences. I won't attempt to detail how the dots connected, but there was a definite thread running through, from one moment to the next, in which the Lord was reminding me that He was with me, speaking to my heart and leading me every step of the way. The task that this left for me was to learn to listen and allow Him to lead.

One example is that I began my retreat with a desire to reflect more on our parish theme for this first year of the Eucharistic Revival (living in the Lord's Presence), but an even greater desire to simply let the Lord lead me wherever He willed. So, I focused my prayer on the readings proposed to me in the Liturgy for those days, along with a few other aides, which I had discerned together with my spiritual director before I left. By the time the retreat was wrapping up, I realized that everything the Lord had been telling me was about how He was inviting me personally to live always in His Presence, especially by better appreciating the gift of His Presence in the Eucharist. This conclusion of the retreat led directly into the drive to Springfield, MO, to meet our group for the Steubenville Youth Conference. That night, we shared together in a powerful time of resting in the Presence of the Lord in Eucharistic Adoration, during which the Lord and I continued to speak about this need to live always in His Presence. That time of adoration with our youth and adult leaders at the conference was the perfect conclusion to my retreat and also the perfect beginning to a blessed weekend together with them, in which He would continue to embolden our hearts to be fearless about striving to live always in His presence. He was present with us in Springfield, MO (partaking in a movement begun in Steubenville, OH), just as He was with you all back in Geneseo, IL, where you were hearing the testimony of a missionary priest about how He is present and active in Ivory Coast in Africa.

And now, I have returned to Geneseo, ready to welcome a team of young adult missionaries from around the diocese to help lead our children and youth and all of us into an experience of the joy of living in the Lord's Presence, through Totus Tuus.

He truly is everywhere and invites us to enter it and remain in His Presence. May we be fearless and strive to *enter more deeply into the way of life of a disciple of Jesus Christ: a life lived in God's presence!*
