



Here we are in the middle of August and I'm catching myself thinking, "Where did this summer go?" Are you asking the same thing?

This week as we are about to embark on another school year, I'm taking some time to pause and reflect on all that transpired within our parish this summer. I am reminded of the energizer bunny commercial from the early 90s and I've definitely felt like that bunny. But, where did all my energy come from? Our summer climax was our Totus Tuus week, which saw 85 students in grades 1-12 encountering Christ and the Blessed Mother through the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary, Mass, and other prayers. Everyone had a great time learning, growing, playing games, and the highlight may have been being able to pour sundae toppings on Father Gifford.

How does a disciple live? In God's Presence. This will be our call and response that Father Gifford will introduce to our students, and we will be working hard to become consciously aware that we are always in God's Presence and continue inviting the children to live as a disciple, choosing to

live each day in His Presence.

With school beginning this Wednesday, I am looking forward to getting to know more students within the school as I will be teaching music two days a week. If you hear loud chaos coming from the room, do not be alarmed. We will just be having lots of fun while learning to play kazoos, drumming, and recorders as well as singing. We are called to *make a joyful noise unto the Lord,* aren't we?

Also, beginning after Labor Day will be The Rock and Oasis Youth Ministry Groups. Bob Thoene and I have some amazing events planned for the coming year for students to do some parish and community outreaches as well as deepening their faith. Oasis will continue to meet on Wednesday nights while The Rock will meet on Thursday nights.

Do not forget about our Activities Fair August 27-28. Please stop by our tables to learn more and hear from our youth about what they experienced this summer.

Lastly, I would like to personally thank each and every one of you for your warm welcome to me this past year as well as your willingness and graciousness to help whenever I have needed it. St. Malachy is definitely a phenomenal parish to be a part of. We are so blessed.
