

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

How does a disciple live? In God's Presence.

Perhaps you've seen this on the Saint Malachy School sign, which sits at our main entrance along Ogden Avenue. This is the new "call and answer" which is used to memorably engage the children in our Year of Presence, the first year of the Eucharistic Revival. It has been a joy to teach this and begin using it with our children at Saint Malachy School and now also our CCD children as of this past week.

When we first began this revival, beginning with the Feast of Corpus Christi in June, you may have noticed that I began usually closing these bulletin letters by reminding us that our focus for this year is to *enter more deeply into the way of life of a disciple of Jesus Christ: a life lived in God's presence!* 

How do we know what the life of a disciple looks like? Well, hopefully, because we are living it. But, we learn first from the Scriptures, by following after the examples of those who first answered His call to follow Him. When we look for this example, a helpful place to start might be found in Our Lord's last recorded words to them, before His return to the Father: "Behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Matthew 28:20) Our confidence that a disciple of Christ lives in God's Presence is rooted in His own promise to His first disciples. It is not, first of all, the action of the disciples themselves that leads them to live always in God's Presence, but the action of God Himself, who promised that He would always be with them. Thus, they would live always in His Presence.

In order to understand this even more fully, we should look at what Our Lord said right before this promise, especially since He returned to the right hand of the Father immediately afterwards. *"All power"* 

in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." This is what is commonly referred to as "the Great Commission." It is the principle mission with which He sent them out. It is the mission of the Church. Perhaps this is the reason that Bishop Lou has chosen "Go Make Disciples" as his motto.

Next week, I will continue to break open the Scriptural testimony to how a disciple lives always in God's Presence. Until then, let us keep our focus upon this central mission of the Church and the leadership of our bishop in helping us keep this focus. Beyond that initial choice of his motto, Bishop Lou began his time as our local ordinary, in his Easter 2022 letter, by proposing this mission as the first of his five foundations: Evangelization, Discipleship, Eucharist, Vocations and the Legacy of Fulton Sheen. More recently, in announcing his Growing Disciples pastoral planning process, he has returned our focus to these foundations, in order to lead the whole diocese in allowing these priorities to guide this crucial process of discerning the path forward for the diocese.

Finally, the theme of his first Annual Diocesan Appeal this year is "Go Make Disciples: Bringing People to Christ!" As the appeal kicks off this weekend and you begin reviewing the materials that have been sent out and posted publicly by the diocese, you will notice that these same foundations provide the focus for the appeal. May they provide focus to all of our efforts to...

Abide in God's Presence: Living from the Source, Striving for the Summit, Christ as our Center.




