

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age" (Matthew 28). Last weekend, our bulletin letter discussed how this final promise of Jesus Christ, before ascending to the right hand of the Father is the basis of our confidence that a disciple always lives in God's presence. This is why we can proclaim, in our "call and answer," How Does a Disciple Live? In God's Presence. Still, this promise comes with a command to take up His mission.

How do we know that the early Christians obeyed this command and took up His mission? A great place to start in answering that guestion would be Acts 2:42. This simple explanation of the life of the early disciples tells us exactly how a disciple lives: "They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers." These four basic elements of the life of a disciple have guided Christians throughout the centuries. The four sections of the Catechism of the Catholic Church are based upon them. Likewise, in our parish study on discipleship from last Spring, Into His Likeness, Dr. Ed Sri uses this same passage as the basis for the practical portion of the study, focused on how a disciple lives after they have encountered Christ and begun to follow Him. Later this week, our next episode of Thursday Thoughts will feature testimony and discussion based on this and other recent studies, as well as our current adult study, The Search. If you missed out on our parish study of Into His Likeness, you can still find it and view it on your own time on Formed.org or purchase and read the book (same title).

Of these four elements of the life of a disciple, is there one that holds special importance? Saint Paul certainly seems to suggest as much in his first letter to the Corinthians. *"The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of*

Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ? Because the loaf of bread is one, we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf." The breaking of bread to which Acts 2:42 told us the early disciples were all devoted, the same Eucharist that we celebrate at every Mass, is the source of the unity of the Body of Christ because it is a true participation in the saving sacrifice of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ on the cross! This is why the Sunday Mass is the Source, Summit and Center of our lives. And this is all living in imitation of Christ who regarded the First Eucharist, which inaugurated His Paschal Mystery, as the climax of His mission: "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer" (Luke 22:15).

This is the secret to living always in God's Presence: let the Sunday Mass be that true Source, Summit and Center of your life and then, devote yourself also to prayer, study (the teaching of the Apostles), and striving to live a good life guided by the commandment to love God and love your neighbor (the communal life). Abide in God's Presence: Living from the Source, Striving for the Summit, Christ as our Center.

VISITORS NEXT WEEKEND: We will have a chance to hear from some individuals who have committed themselves to the command of Christ in Matthew 28, in a very unique and extraordinary way, next weekend. I have invited two FOCUS Missionaries (Fellowship of Catholic University Students), Dillon and Khaila Pariseau, to come share with us briefly about their mission and how you can support and share in it. Thank you in advance for making them feel welcome.
