A Note From the Pastor

Welcome back to The Search and Where It Leads You. This bulletin letter series began midway through the parish study of *The Search*, in order to supplement it, both for those participating in one of the groups, for those who may be watching the videos on their own and for those who may still be considering doing so. Remember, that is part of the beauty of our parish subscription to FORMED.org: if schedule conflicts or other complications prevent you from participating in one of the groups, you should be able to access it from home to watch the parish study (or countless other great Catholic materials) on your own or with a smaller group of friends or family on your own schedule. Well, by the weekend when this letter is posted in the bulletin, the parish study of The Search has completed and our groups are preparing to dive next into *Lectio: Philippians*. I highly recommend joining in on this next study. But, I would also recommend anyone who hasn't yet gone through *The Search* and *Presence* (which was the concluding study for last Spring, serving as a prelude to the Eucharistic Revival), to consider devoting either some of your personal or small group time to one or both of these great studies.

Meanwhile, we will continue with this series, as we still have a few more episodes to discuss. This week, we come to Episode 5: Who Is Jesus? This is the question at the heart of it all. The Person of Jesus Christ stands at the center of history, the center of the Gospel and the Church and hopefully at the center of our lives. As we have been reiterating throughout this first year of the Eucharistic Revival, part of abiding in God's Presence is Living from the Source, Striving for the Summit, with *Christ as our Center*. Truly, part of the uniqueness of the Christian faith is that the Good News we bring to the world, is not simply a message, but a Person. And that Person is God, who has truly become man. Fully God, fully human. God has become one of us... in order to save us. Jesus Christ Himself IS the Good News! He stands at the center of this study. Having explored the nature of creation, of who we are, of who God is and the nature of the ongoing story of our journey with God throughout history, we have begun to explore the landscape into which Jesus Christ enters. This context helps us to begin to ask the question, who is this Person really... and what does He have to do with me?

Why should He be the Center of my life? And what might that look like? These questions will continue to be explored even more fully in the two remaining sessions, which consider all He has done for us. These sessions will focus on salvation and the Church.

Where can we go deeper in exploring who Jesus is? Prayer. Hands down, this is the best and most important answer. Get to know Jesus. Talk to Him, listen to Him, sit with Him in the silence each day. This is the answer that matters most. But, since this series promises to make a recommendation from Formed.org each week, I would also recommend *Lectio: The Case for Jesus*. In this series, Dr. Brant Pitre focuses on the Scriptural evidence of who Jesus is, while also consulting other relevant historical documents, but engages that content in an orderly and scientific manner, in order to investigate many questions that have arisen through the years, which question the identity of our Blessed Lord. Along the way, he effectively demonstrates the lack of merit of some more recent theories, which have become popular in Scripture study. On a personal note, some of these theories were taught to my peers and I in seminary, causing us to scratch our heads and say, "This doesn't seem right." I am so thankful that Dr. Pitre has done the work to credibly clarify the truth of who Jesus is and how He reveals Himself to us in the Scriptures. One of the great end results of this series is that it strengthens our faith in the credibility of the Scriptures, that we may continue to passionately open our Bibles and spend time with them, trusting that they bring us into contact with the Real Person of Jesus Christ.

Abide in God's Presence: Living from the Source, Striving for the Summit, Christ as our Center. "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer" (Luke 22:15).

Saint Malachy Novena: This Friday, we will begin our annual tradition of praying our parish novena, in order to prepare for the Feast of Saint Malachy, which we will celebrate the weekend of November 5-6. Each day during the novena, you may join us in the church at noon for a half hour of Eucharistic Adoration, beginning with the novena prayers. Or you can follow along at home using copies available online or limited printed copies in the Narthex.
