A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

Abide in God's Presence: Living from the Source, Striving for the Summit, Christ as our Center. "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer" (Luke 22:15). This has been our focus since we began the Eucharistic Revival on Corpus Christi (June 19, 2022). Now, as we come to the conclusion of the Church Year, with the great Feast of Christ the King, we come to a definite turning point, as we are now midway through the Year of Presence. In the coming weeks, you will notice a shift in emphasis on how we strive to abide in the Lord's Presence, by living with the Eucharist as our Source, Summit and Center. I'll elaborate on that in Advent. For now, let us remember that Eucharist means THANKSGIVING. I want to wish everyone a very blessed holiday this week. May it be a time when we show gratitude to God and others for the many blessings of the past year.

And as we gratefully look back on this beginning of this Eucharistic Revival, by considering the call and answer that we have been using with our children this year: How does a disciple live? In God's Presence. Our emphasis on living always in the Presence of God is meant to draw our attention to a fundamental building block of the life of a disciple. Do you identify as a disciple of Jesus Christ? Have you made a choice to follow Him? Does this choice provide the foundation and direction for your life, giving guidance to all other decisions, especially those important life decisions? If so, how are you doing? Are you walking with Him today or do you recognize Him inviting you back to His side? If not, why not? What's stopping you from joining me in the prayer, from the depth of your heart?

Jesus, You have given me life and have given Your own life on the cross so that I may have the gift of life abundantly. I want to live this new life to the full. Help me to trust You to lead me each day. I choose today, with the help of Your grace, to give my life to You, since

You gave Your life for me, not to live for my own selfish desires, but to strive humbly to leave sin behind and instead to follow you into the resurrected life that you have made possible by Your own death and resurrection. Jesus Christ, our King, be the King of my heart and of my life. Amen.

If you've said this prayer, and especially if it was the first time you've prayed a prayer like this... *get ready*. Because it's just the beginning. As has been said numerous times, following Christ is the greatest of adventures. But, why would I make this invitation? First, because asking the question of whether Christ is truly the King of my own life is indeed a fitting way to honor the Feast of Christ the King. Secondly, because the whole mission of the Church is to make disciples and discipleship begins with this simple choice to follow Jesus. As we conclude the Church Year, it is a fitting moment to recall this mission of making disciples, which Christ entrusted to the Church before ascending to the Father (Matthew 28). For this reason, it is the first of the five pillars, on which Bishop Lou has asked us to keep our focus: Evangelization, Eucharist, Discipleship, Vocations and the Legacy of Fulton Sheen. Over the past couple of weeks, I have begun a series within Thursday Thoughts of focusing on these five pillars in order to best situate ourselves to consider more closely the Diocesan pastoral planning process Growing Disciples. As part of this initiative, the bishop has asked us to pray the Growing Disciples Prayer. Let us close with the beginning of this prayer.

Heavenly Father, you have sown the seeds of faith in your people and given us the responsibility as the Church to nurture and grow an abundant harvest for the Kingdom of God. Send forth, we pray, the grace of the Holy Spirit to allow us to discern a path forward as we read the signs of our times. Amen.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As Jesus began his public ministry, he called twelve Apostles to join him. When his ministry was complete, just before he ascended to heaven, he entrusted the mission to go make disciples to the Apostles while granting them his own power and authority through the gift of the Holy Spirit. While the Apostles were called specifically to the ministerial priesthood, they were not without support in their ministry. Many others, men and women, some who were acknowledged by name, and others who remained anonymous, provided support for them out of their means (cf. Lk. 8:1-3). To this day, our Lord continues to call men to himself for the sake of priestly ministry. Likewise, there remains the need to provide support for these men, especially during the time of a man's formal formation within the seminary.

We are currently blessed with 22 seminarians and there are others already applying for the coming year! Without including the expense of operating the Office of Vocations, the education alone - tuition, room and board - costs around \$270,000 per seminarian over the course of his six years of philosophical and graduate level studies in Theology.

In the diocese of Peoria, we do not lament the fact that we are burdened with these costs. Rather, we are thankful that Jesus has called so many men who are willing to enter seminary formation in order to be future priests serving your parishes and families. For this reason, we have chosen to focus attention on this Thanksgiving holiday to thank God for our seminarians and to thank God for all who provide for them.

I ask you to prayerfully consider making a financial donation towards priestly vocations at mass on Sunday, November 27th, the Sunday after Thanksgiving. Your gift will directly contribute to the education of our seminarians. Your generous support is much needed and greatly appreciated.
