

A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

As we continue the Gospel of Matthew Challenge. let's consider a moment from the climax of the Gospel, when our Lord's Passion begins. "While he was still speaking, Judas, one of the Twelve, arrived, accompanied by a large crowd, with swords and clubs, who had come from the chief priests and the elders of the people. His betrayer had arranged a sign with them, saying, "The man I shall kiss is the one; arrest him." Immediately he went over to Jesus and said, "Hail, Rabbi!" and he kissed him. Jesus answered him, "Friend, do what you have come for." Then stepping forward they laid hands on Jesus and arrested him. And behold, one of those who accompanied Jesus put his hand to his sword, drew it, and struck the high priest's servant, cutting off his ear. Then Jesus said to him, "Put your sword back into its sheath, for all who take the sword will perish by the sword." (Matthew 26:47-52)

If ever there were a moment when one might understandably argue that violence could be justified, it would have been this moment! And yet, in this moment, Our Lord makes clear His consistent commitment to peace. Throughout history, we have seen the horrors that war brings. "To everyone I affirm that peace is possible. It needs to be implored from God as his gift, but it also needs to be built day by day with his help, through works of justice and love. To be sure, the problems which make the path to peace difficult and often discouraging are many and complex, but peace is a need deeply rooted in the heart of every man and woman. The will to seek peace must not therefore be allowed to weaken... War is a defeat for humanity." (Pope Saint John Paul II).

In light of the invasion into Ukraine one year ago this month, this is a fitting time to devote our second Works of Mercy Holy Hour to praying for peace in our world. By this time, a great many lives have been lost and a great many more have been afflicted with great hardship. Therefore, in addition to praying for an end to this war and an increase in peace worldwide, we must also be mindful of that Work of Mercy that teaches us to "Comfort the Afflicted." Therefore, the collection which will take place will be devoted to relief for Ukraine, through an organization called Aid for the

Church in Need.

The Holy Hour for Peace begins at 7 PM on February 20, taking place during the last hour of the weekly Monday Adoration. Like last month, the basket will be available near the altar in the chapel, for those who cannot make the 7 PM Holy Hour, but would like to come and offer prayers at one of the earlier hours and leave a donation for Aid for the Church in Need. Let us commit ourselves to being a people of peace and let us always look for ways that we can comfort those who are afflicted.

The Church is alive in the Diocese of Peoria!



Your child <u>can</u> attend a Catholic School Financial Assistance Available



Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2023-2024 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from any Catholic elementary or secondary school in the Diocese of Peoria or on the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under *Catholic Education* and then under *Financial Assistance*. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award.

Parents must apply online at: **online.factsmgt.com/aid**. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2023-2024 school year must reapply.

Deadline date for the completed application is April 28, 2023. Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2023.

Another funding opportunity is also available due to the Invest in Kids Act legislation in Illinois. Students may be eligible for up to 100% of tuition and fees under a new program for tax credit scholarships (TCS). Details on how to apply and who qualifies are available on the Empower Illinois website at **www.empowerillinois.org**. Students who receive a TCS are ineligible to receive a Spalding award.
