Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Loving Mother of the Redeemer, Gate of Heaven, Star of Sea, assist your people who have fallen, yet strive to rise again. To the wonderment of nature you bore your Creator, yet remained a virgin after as before. You who received Gabriel's joyful greeting, have pity on us poor sinners." Among the many beautiful prayers to Our Lady, this one has long had a special place in my heart. In this Month of Mary, we ask the Mother of our Redeemer to reveal the tenderness of her Immaculate Heart, which beats, bleeds and breaks in unison with the Sacred Heart of Christ, her Son.


