A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Go make disciples of all nations." This weekend, we hear this Great Commission being given to the whole Church. That includes Saint Malachy Parish. The particular ways that we answer this call requires constant prayerful discernment, that we may follow wherever the Lord is leading us.

Over a decade ago, our parish heard and answered a call to "Go Make Disciples in Tennessee." As you may be aware, we have had a relationship with St. Teresa of Kolkata Catholic Church in Maynardville, TN, as our sister parish since 2011. Thanks to the organizational leadership of Glenmary Home Missioners, this relationship has born good fruit through the years. Our parishioners who have visited our sister parish and walked with them through the early days of their growth and development testify to how the experience invited them to a deeper appreciation of our Catholic faith, which we can so easily take for granted. Likewise, we have been able to assist them in the growth from the point of their first Mass in the resident carport to their current status today, as a parish with its own church building, an active community and a growing faith formation program. We are thankful to God for this relationship.

This relationship was able to be successful because it had the active support of active members of the parish who were answering a call from the Lord to take on this particular mission. However, most of them are no longer active members of our parish, while the others are currently being called to direct their energies elsewhere. This brings us to a moment of discernment, for us to invite the Holy Spirit to reveal His holy will to us. The commitment that was made in 2011 has been fulfilled and we have not yet seen that next generation of parishioners come forward. who are being called to take on the rebuilding of this relationship, which has been relatively dormant in recent years. The matter has been discussed numerous times in both the Social Justice Committee and Parish Council over the past three years. Recently, the decision was reached that the time has come to bring the matter to the broader parish community.

The moment of discernment that is before us is a question of whether we are being called to rebuild this relationship. If we had 3-5 families or individual parishioners interested in being the ones to devote time and energy to rebuilding that relationship, this would be a sign that the Lord may be calling the parish in that direction. If that does not happen, it may be a sign that we are being called to move on and direct our energies elsewhere, having fulfilled the initial call of our commitment as a sister parish. We will take the summer to discern this guestion and make a decision about the future of our relationship by September. So, please take this to prayer and if you are interested in being actively involved with rebuilding a relationship with St. Teresa of Kolkata, please let me know. A few years ago, Maynardville parishioners took up a collection, in order for us to have a visible remembrance of their patron. Mother Teresa here at Saint Malachy. Arrangements are underway to reveal and bless the beautiful picture that they have made possible for us on her feast day, September 5. We will make a final decision before then. May Sts Malachy and Mother Teresa pray for us, that we may know and do the Lord's Will in all thinas.
