





## *A Note From the Pastor*



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

*“They set out at once and returned to Jerusalem where they found gathered together the eleven and those with them... Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of the bread”* (Luke 24:33,35). This has been our focus in this still new Year of Missionary Discipleship, the second year of the Eucharistic Revival. And these words from the conclusion of that Easter Story from the road to Emmaus have been our theme verse since we entered this new year, on Corpus Christi (June 11) 2023.

Now that school is back in session and things are starting back up, we are going to relaunch this important and special year in the life of the Church. This is the purpose of **MISSION MONTH (September 2023)**, which you may have seen or heard advertised in recent weeks. So, what exactly is Mission Month? It is basically a parish mission, stretched out over the course of a month to relaunch the Year of Missionary Discipleship, by helping us embrace the mission of making Him more widely known. How will we do this? Our focus will be to rediscover how the Lord Jesus makes Himself known to us, through the GIFT of the Eucharist (see our theme verse above) so that we can go out and share it with the world. It all begins with letting Him make Himself known to us, first of all in the Holy Eucharist.

What will this special Mission Month consist of? You will notice the difference right away on the first Sunday, when we will begin each Mass, with a parishioner testimony. These testimonies will continue each week in September. We will also have a special Kick-Off Event on the first Wednesday of the month

(September 6th @ 7 PM), with Scripture, prayers and a meditation, designed to lead straight into ADORE (our monthly time of adoration with prayerful music, readings and quiet reflection). The Featured Event will be our visit from The Vatican International Exhibition of the Eucharistic Miracles of the World. They will offer a special presentation for adults and teens at 6:30 PM on Wednesday, September 13th. Saint Malachy School and CCD students will receive special presentations during their class time. That weekend (September 16-17), the exhibit will be open for visitors to walk through. There will be a lot to take in. You will be amazed to see all the ways that the Lord has confirmed through the years the reality of His True Presence, in the Holy Eucharist! Finally, all of these awesome opportunities will prepare us for our Holy Hour with the Diocesan Traveling Monstrance (Thursday, September 21 @ 6:30 PM).

So, you may be wondering what then? How will we begin to make Him more widely known? Yes, it begins with letting Him make Himself known to us, but isn't the point that this gift is meant to be shared? Absolutely! The first answer to that question is that you are encouraged to invite friends and neighbors to any of these events. Also, if you keep your hearts and your eyes open, the Lord will likely give you opportunities to share with others both the information and inspiration that you receive. More information will be coming about more ways that we are encouraging everyone to carry this Good News into our local community and help make Him more widely known. May this be a time for all of us to renew and deepen our appreciation of the gift of God, whose love for us is so great that He makes Himself present to us in every age, through the Holy Eucharist.





Excitement from parents who are ready for the kids to go back to school and even some students who are ready to see their teachers and friends again. Then panic sets in. Families want to squeeze in one more vacation, family event, or trip before the hustle and bustle of busy school activities.

We should not look at school as the thief of carefree days. School provides a valuable benefit. Students attend school to learn and gain knowledge as they grow to become responsible citizens. Every single person has a unique gift given to them by God. Some will excel in math, others in English, or perhaps in PE or some sport activity. Every teacher strives to get the best out of their students, as students use their ability to honor God.

worldwide.


