







A Note From the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"None of us lives for oneself... For if we live, we live for the Lord... we are the Lord's." (Romans 14:7-9). These words of Saint Paul, from this weekend's second reading, call a few things to mind. First, this

reading is one that is used frequently at funerals. If anyone reading this is prompted to remember your loved one, please find comfort and inspiration in the example they left behind of not living for oneself. And may God's blessing strengthen you, as you honor their legacy, by following their example.

Second, they remind me of the fact that we are not our own, but are a part of something so much bigger than ourselves. When we consider this in light of our Eucharistic Revival, we can remember that, while there are some aspects specific to our parish (for example, the Year of Missionary Discipleship is a unique theme for Saint Malachy), we are united in this effort with the diocese and beyond. One of Bishop Lou's efforts to emphasize diocesan unity in this revival is the **Diocesan Traveling Monstrance**. Parishes around the diocese have been hosting special Holy Hours with this monstrance and this **Thursday, September 21**, it is our turn. Since this is a special opportunity to acknowledge our unity with the whole diocese in this Eucharistic Revival and also a fitting final "official" event of Mission Month, after the Eucharistic Miracles (don't forget you still have time to visit the exhibits on Saturday and Sunday; see the bulletin for details), this will not be like any other holy hour. We will have music, readings, guided prayers and a reflection. This will take the place of our usual Thursday evening liturgy schedule and Mass will be moved to 8 AM.

However, even this is not quite the end of Mission Month. We will have one more testimony next weekend. Additionally, I am asking everyone to think and pray about someone to invite to the **OCIA (formerly known as RCIA) Informational Night on Tuesday, September 26th at 6 PM**. This is simply an opportunity for those who even think they might be interested (no commitments necessary) to come, have some refreshments, meet the team as well as others who recently went through the class, learn about it and ask questions. It should not take more than an hour. All are

welcome, including parishioners who are considering attending for their own ongoing faith formation.

This brings me to another point. Recently, I shared 7 reasons someone might consider OCIA. You might have noticed that it is not only for those who are not yet Catholic. Sometimes we have participants in the class who are Catholics, simply looking to renew and deepen their own faith formation. This is not only a great opportunity for the Catholic participating, but can also add a lot to the class dynamic, which enriches and benefits everyone. It may seem strange, since the word "initiation" is part of the name of OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults). However, consider the three Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. Only the first two can only be received once. Holy Eucharist is recommended to be received every week, if not more frequently. Yet, this is part of our initiation, not simply the first time, but every time. It is not simply about our own private relationship with the Lord, but about Christ bringing us into communion with Himself, which brings us into communion with one another and into the Holy Trinity. This communion is a reality into which we enter ever more deeply throughout our life of faith. So, we might say that our initiation into the Body of Christ is still ongoing.

May we rediscover His Love and seek to make Him more widely known! *"They set out at once and returned to Jerusalem where they found gathered together the eleven and those with them... Then the two recounted what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them in the breaking of the bread"* (Luke 24:33,35).

NEW PARISH DIRECTORIES: Our new parish directories have recently arrived. As promised, they are well worth the wait. As I said last week at Mass, the "2022" on the top of a directory that is finally in our hands late in 2023 can serve as a sign of just how much hard work and perseverance went into them. Please join me in thanking our directory committee: Caryn Vandersnick, David & AJ Wolak, Sue Emerson, Mary Sebastian, and Dcn. Robert O'Rourke. Also, thanks to everyone who had their picture taken, submitted one or contributed in any way.
