A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,



"Was it not necessary that the Messiah should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" (Luke 24:26). All of the Scriptures had been leading up to this. Not only would

God keep His promise to send us a savior who would deliver us, but He would suffer out of love for us. And the glory into which He would be entering would be far greater than imagined: Resurrection from the dead! This is the Good News. Let us dive in with our whole hearts!

Welcome to the second step of our Three Step Journey of Lent: Dive Into the Good News! This is ultimately what Our Lord was doing in our theme verse. Some have referred to His explanations to the two disciples on the way to Emmaus as a "Bible study on the road." However, perhaps more accurately, it is also often referred to as the Liturgy of the Word. He prepared them for the encounter with Him at the breaking of the bread, when their eyes would finally be opened to recognize Him, by breaking open the Scriptures for them. He still does the same for us today at every Mass.

There are many ways we can dive into the Good News, as long as it involves praying with the Scriptures and especially the Gospel. In particular, I want to thank and encourage everyone who has been joining in on the Gospel of Mark Challenge. Of course, the counting is still running at the time that I am writing this letter, but currently we already have 182 people participating. What a joy to be sharing this experience together! Let us remember to pray for one another.

It should be noted that when we read Scripture, it should never be either merely casual or merely academic. We read to listen to the Word of God. What does this mean? We should always begin in prayer. A simple prayer such as: "Come, Holy Spirit. Help me to set aside distraction and focus all of my thoughts, affections and will on You during this time that I may hear

Your Voice and respond in loving humility, gratitude and obedience. Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening." (1 Samuel 3:10)

Read slowly, pay attention both to the content of the reading and to how your heart is responding. When a particular word, image or passage moves your heart, notice it. If possible, pause for a brief moment even then and rest in it. Regardless, make a note so that you can come back to it and spend time there in prayer.

Saint Ignatius of Loyola taught us of the principle of repetition: when we find a place where the Lord has moved our hearts, we should consider it like discovering a well, to which we can return often. Especially when we are moving at a fast pace of one chapter per day, it is important to come back and spend time with those passages, words and images that have especially moved the heart, to draw from those deep and endless wells where the Lord meets us. Try to identify at least one passage per week, to which you will come back and spend quality time. The depths waiting for us within the Good News are beyond imagining. Let us dive in with abandon.

This is a fantastic event that brings together the larger school community to support the school that we love. I want to express my deep thanks to Parents Club for their leadership and organization of this event and for all who have attended and/or supported it. Just having celebrated our 100 Year Anniversary a few weeks ago, it is such a great joy to be reminded and to celebrate that the support that has brought us to this point is still alive and well.

John Lancaster Spalding Scholarship Fund Grants Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2024-2025 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under the heading Catholic Education and then under Financial Assistance. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award. Parents must apply at: https://online.factsmgt.com/aid. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2024-2025 school year must reapply. Deadline date for the completed application is April 26, 2024. Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2024.

Another funding opportunity is also available due to the Invest in Kids Act legislation in Illinois. Students may be eligible for up to 100% of tuition and fees under a new program for tax credit scholarships (TCS). Details on how to apply and who qualifies are available on the Empower Illinois website at www.empowerillinois.org. Students who receive a TCS are ineligible to receive a Spalding award.



Adding spiritual practices during Lent can instill habits of faith that provide an experiential understanding of spiritual truth and nurture the inclination to sustain a Lenten practice throughout the year or for a lifetime.

- Do an examination of conscience daily if you don't already
- •Say the rosary each day for the intentions of someone else
