



A Note From the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

He is Risen. Alleluia! *“After this He appeared in another form to two of them walking along on their way to the country. They returned and told the others; but they did not believe them either”* (Mark 16:12-13). This weekend, we will hear the *end* of Luke’s version of this very same story in our Gospel at Mass. In fact, the opening line of this weekend’s Gospel has served as one of our theme verses for this year: *“The two disciples recounted what had taken place on the way, and how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of bread* (Luke 24).” Again, we can see how the breaking of the bread became for them a place of encounter with the Lord, which prompted them to go and share this Good News (Rejoice!). May the Eucharist always have this effect on each of us.

Still, this weekend’s Gospel invites us to recognize the correlation between the Risen Lord’s appearance to the two disciples on the road and His appearance to the disciples gathered together in Jerusalem. Just as He opened the Scriptures to the two on the road, so also He opened the minds of the disciples in Jerusalem to understand the Scriptures. On the way, He began “with Moses and all the prophets.” In Jerusalem, He told them “that everything written about me in the law of Moses and in the prophets and the psalms must be fulfilled.” Also, on the road, He had revealed that these Old Testament Scriptures “referred to Him.” Thus, we can see a reference to the Scriptures as being fulfilled in Christ.

We should also consider the role of eating in both encounters. While at table with the two disciples He met on the road, only one course is mentioned: “He took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them.” Thus, it is later described as “the breaking of the bread,” using the terminology with which the Early Church often spoke of the Mass (Acts 2:42). The Lectionary conveniently includes this reference to the breaking of the bread as the beginning of the story of His appearance in Jerusalem, where He will then eat fish with them. The combination of bread and fish is striking. Consider when Jesus fed the five thousand (Matthew 14). What was it that He multiplied? Loaves of bread and fish. And again, we find bread and fish feeding the four thousand (Matthew 15). Consider also another feast with the Risen Christ. After a miraculous catch of fish (John 21), He

has breakfast on the beach with them, consisting of bread and fish.

This all seems to point to the combination that is often found between bread and *flesh*, of various kinds. First, consider the gift of manna, which was given also with quail (Exodus 16). Next, consider how the Passover feast consisted primarily of consuming the flesh of the lamb and unleavened bread (Exodus 12). These combinations of bread and flesh prepare the way for the Eucharist, in which Jesus tells us that “the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world” (John 6) and at first Eucharist itself, He took the bread and said this is My Body (Mark 14). Thus, the Resurrection feasts of bread and fish remind us of how the earlier combinations of bread and flesh (in the manna and quail, in the Passover and in the multiplications of loaves and fish) prefigured the Eucharist, in which the bread and flesh are one. May we approach the bread of life ready to ENCOUNTER the Risen Christ, so that we may GROW in His grace and truth and GO share the Good News with the world.

OUR PARISH FAMILY GROWING: Today, I am happy to be able to share with you the Good News that we will be celebrating an adult baptism and two confirmations at the 10:30 Mass on the 5th Sunday of Easter (April 28)! Richard Ferkel will be welcomed into full communion with the Catholic Church, as he is baptized, confirmed and receives his first Holy Communion. Together with him, his wife Brooke will be completing her initiation by being confirmed as well. Brooke and Richard are regulars at the 10:30 Mass and have been a part of our parish family, along with their children Fiona and Killian, since April of 2016. It will be a great joy to celebrate with them as they take this new step forward in their faith journey!

CLARIFICATION REGARDING BOOK: Recently, a book began to be circulated throughout Geneseo, which has elicited questions from our parishioners. The book is *The Rise and Fall of Jerusalem* by E.G. White, which claims to be prophetic. You should be aware that the content of this book is not Catholic, cannot be considered authentically prophetic and is closely linked with strong anti-Catholic ideas. John Lancaster Spalding Scholarship Fund Grants Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2024-2025 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under the heading Catholic Education and then under Financial Assistance. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award.

Parents must apply at: <https://online.factsmgmt.com/aid>. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2024-2025 school year must reapply.

Deadline date for the completed application is **April 26, 2024**. Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2024.

Another funding opportunity is also available due to the Invest in Kids Act legislation in Illinois. Students may be eligible for up to 100% of tuition and fees under a new program for tax credit scholarships (TCS). Details on how to apply and who qualifies are available on the Empower Illinois website at www.empowerillinois.org. Students who receive a TCS are ineligible to receive a Spalding award.




