

## A Note From the Pastor

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,



He is Risen. Alleluia! "After this He appeared in another form to two of them walking along on their way to the country. They returned and told the others; but they did not believe them either" (Mark

16:12-13). It is worth noting the simplicity of Mark's account of this encounter of the two disciples on the road with the Risen Jesus, which has provided our theme verses for this Year of Missionary Discipleship. On one hand, it can leave us wanting a little more. Although, that's not such a bad thing. Wise people have said, "Always leave them wishing you said more, not less." I bet Mark agreed with that advice. But, it is perhaps understandable that his short two verse long version of the story often gets overlooked or forgotten, in favor of Luke's richer and more detailed version (Luke 24:13-35). Still, there is beauty in the fact that Mark leaves all of those details in the realm of hidden intimacy. Luke almost certainly wrote his gospel after Mark wrote his and may well have had read it. You can imagine Luke saying, "You know that story Mark mentioned? It's a beautiful story! Let me tell it to you." How many encounters do we have with the Risen Jesus that remain in that realm of hidden intimacy? Sometimes, when the moment is right, the Holy Spirit moves us to share with someone or with a group the beautiful stories behind those encounters. In such moments, we remember that we have been sent to share His Good News, and yet with the simplicity of sharing our own experience. Let us be ready to share these stories with others when we are so moved. But, let us also simply be ready to meet the Lord. Even in hidden intimate encounters that may remain between us and Him. Even at the altar. May we approach the bread of life ready to ENCOUNTER the Risen Christ, so that we may GROW in His grace and truth and GO share the Good News with the

world.

GOING BACK TO SCHOOL: In this Year of Missionary Discipleship, it is fitting that I be reminded of my own missionary discipleship. While I have been out on mission as a priest for about twelve years (thirteen years as a deacon), I am still a disciple, still a student, still with a lot to learn. Earlier this year, I applied and was accepted into a Spiritual Direction Training Program through the Institute for Priestly Formation (IPF). This is an aspect of my formation which I have long desired to go back and complete, which will enable me to be of much better assistance to God's people in Spiritual Direction. Reconciliation and other spiritual conversations. When I participated in the summer program for seminarians offered by IPF back in 2008, it was one of the most beneficial and impactful experiences I have ever had, which has borne great fruit both in my personal spiritual life and in my capacity to serve others in helping them to deepen their spiritual lives. I am greatly looking forward to the benefits of this next stage in the journey. This program is three years long and consists of three non-consecutive week-long each vear sessions hosted at Mundelein Seminary. The first of these sessions is next week: April 28-May 3. I will be leaving after the 10:30 Mass on Sunday and will return on Friday evening. In my absence. Communion Service will be offered in place of Daily Mass and no Confessions will be available. On Friday, our Vocations Director, Fr. Chase Hilgenbrinck will be the guest celebrant for the School Mass for Special Guest Day.

Another funding opportunity is also available due to the Invest in Kids Act legislation in Illinois. Students may be eligible for up to 100% of tuition and fees under a new program for tax credit scholarships (TCS). Details on how to apply and who qualifies are available on the Empower Illinois website at www.empowerillinois.org. Students who receive a TCS are ineligible to receive a Spalding award.


