A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Now the Son of Man has been glorified and God has been glorified in Him" (John 13:31b). As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, we might recall how 20 years ago Saint John Paul II (who officially declared this Second Sunday of Easter to be Divine Mercy Sunday in obedience to the Lord in His appearances to Saint Faustina) went home to the Lord. This past week, we experienced something similar, as another beloved pope passed during the Easter Octave. With the sudden passing of Pope Francis on Easter Monday morning, we should remember him in our prayers, as well as praying for the man who will be our next pope and for the cardinals who will select him to be guided by the Holy Spirit. Since the Lord allowed Pope Francis to be with us for one final Easter Sunday, we will spend the Easter Season reading his final Easter address in segments, beginning this weekend:

"Mary Magdalene, seeing that the stone of the tomb had been rolled away, ran to tell Peter and John. After receiving the shocking news, the two disciples also went out and, as the Gospel says, 'the two were running together'" (Jn 20:4). The main figures of the Easter narratives all ran! On the one hand, "running" could express the concern that the Lord's body had been taken away; but, on the other hand, the haste of Mary Magdalene, Peter and John expresses the desire, the yearning of the heart, the inner attitude of those who set out to search for Jesus. He, in fact, has risen from the dead and therefore is no longer in the tomb. We must look for Him elsewhere.

This is the message of Easter: we must look for Him elsewhere. Christ is risen, He is alive! He is no longer a prisoner of death, He is no longer wrapped in the shroud, and therefore we cannot confine Him to a fairy tale, we cannot make Him a hero of the ancient world, or think of Him as a statue in a museum! On the contrary, we must look for Him and this is why we cannot remain stationary. We must take action, set out to look for Him: look for Him in life, look for Him in the faces of our brothers and sisters,

look for Him in everyday business, look for Him everywhere except in the tomb."

IMPORTANT NEWS FROM ST. MALACHY SCHOOL: Recently, St. Malachy School communicated with its school families that due to the enrollment of only three students, sixth grade will not be offered for the upcoming academic year (2025-2026). This decision has only been made only for the upcoming school year. However, since the significant downward trend of sixth grade enrollment has been developing for several years even while overall school enrollment remains strong, it necessarily relates to discernment about the future. We consider the feedback that we receive from members of our Saint Malachy School community to be vital in this process of discernment. As we plan for the future, we are approaching this decision with careful consideration, prayer, and discernment of what is best for our entire student body and staff. We have begun to receive and consider feedback and insights from families and staff as we evaluate the long-term future of 6th grade at St. Malachy School and we have asked for this feedback by May 9th. Based on a proposed timeline from the Education Commission, a decision will be announced by the end of the first quarter-October 10, 2025. This information was not immediately shared with the parish at large because my focus was Holy Week. I regret that this may have left parishioners feeling that they should have been included sooner. Saint Malachy School is blessed to have the support of a large community of highly invested parishioners and friends and this is one of our great strengths. For this reason, your feedback will also be a vital contribution to this process. You are encouraged to share with me any feedback that you have to offer by May 9th. As always, let us be united in love and prayer for the school that we love, which has been entrusted to us by God, that our students may grow in love of the Lord and be witnesses to His Resurrection in the world.

In Memory of Father Pakula, St. Malachy Parish will have a monthly theme to collect items for the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry.

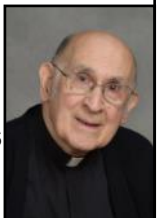
The theme for **May** is:

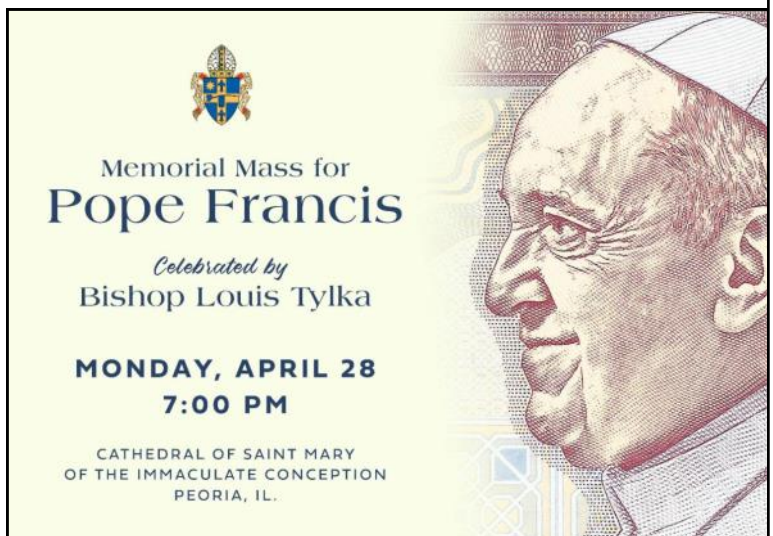

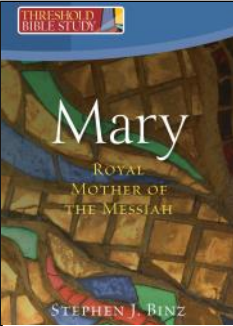
