



A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

Let us continue our gradual read through Pope Leo XIV's very first homily as pope, given to the College of Cardinals, in the Sistine Chapel, the day after his election:

reflect on the scene we are considering, we might find two possible answers, which characterize two different attitudes. First, there is the world's response. Matthew tells us that this conversation between Jesus and his disciples takes place in the beautiful town of Caesarea Philippi, filled with luxurious palaces, set in a magnificent natural cruel power plays and the scene of betrayals and infidelity. This setting speaks to us of a world that considers Jesus a completely insignificant person, at best someone with an unusual and striking way of speaking and acting. And so, once his presence becomes irksome because of his demands for honesty and his stern moral requirements, this "world" will not hesitate to reject and eliminate him. Then there is the other possible response to Jesus' question: that of ordinary people. For them, the Nazarene is not a charlatan, but an upright man, one who has courage, who speaks well and says the right things, like other great prophets in the history of Israel. That is why they follow him, at least for as long as they can do so without too much risk or inconvenience. Yet to them he is only a man, and therefore, in times of danger, during his passion, they too abandon him and depart disappointed. What is striking about these two attitudes is their relevance today. They embody notions that we could easily find on the lips of many men and women in our own time, even if, while essentially identical, they are expressed in different languages. Even today, there are many settings in which the Christian faith is considered absurd, meant for the weak and unintelligent. Settings where other securities are preferred, like technology, money, success, power, or pleasure."

These words of Pope Leo reveal to us the urgency of helping the world come to know the Real Jesus, which

means that we ourselves must come to know Him better. In the Person of Jesus Christ, we see proof of the intensity of God's desire to be close to us. Let us choose to be close to Him today and to allow Him to reveal Himself to us.

FATHER'S DAY: This weekend, we honor our fathers with deep gratitude and respect. Consider the words of Saint John Paul II: "The place and task of the father in and for the family is of unique and irreplaceable ""Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" If we importance... In revealing and in reliving on earth the very fatherhood of God. a man is called upon to ensure the harmonious and united development of all the members of the family." As a spiritual father, these words still provide me with rich food for contemplation, regarding the call to spiritual fatherhood, united in love with Holy Mother Church. And I know priests aren't the only spiritual fathers. landscape at the foot of Mount Hermon, but also a place of All men are called to be fathers, in one way or another, as we make our lives a gift to give life to others, in collaboration with supportive communities in which we can serve as powerful agents of unity. Happy Fathers Day to all of the father figures in our lives!




