## *A Letter from the Pastor*



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

Let us continue our gradual read through Pope Leo XIV's very first homily as pope, given to the College of Cardinals, in the Sistine Chapel, the day after his election:

*"Even today, there are many settings in which the Christian faith is considered absurd, meant for the weak and unintelligent. Settings where other securities are preferred, like technology, money, success, power, or pleasure. These are contexts where it is not easy to preach the Gospel and bear witness to its truth, where believers are mocked, opposed, despised or at best tolerated and pitied. Yet, precisely for this reason, they are the places where our missionary outreach is desperately needed. A lack of faith is often tragically accompanied by the loss of meaning in life, the neglect of mercy, appalling violations of human dignity, the crisis of the family and so many other wounds that afflict our society. Today, too, there are many settings in which Jesus, although appreciated as a man, is reduced to a kind of charismatic leader or superman. This is true not only among non-believers but also among many baptized Christians, who thus end up living, at this level, in a state of practical atheism. This is the world that has been entrusted to us, a world in which, as Pope Francis taught us so many times, we are called to bear witness to our joyful faith in Christ the Saviour. Therefore, it is essential that we too repeat, with Peter: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Mt 16:16)."*

These words of Pope Leo XIV call us to remember that the same world that so often does not take our faith seriously is the same world that desperately needs it. Let us, then, not hesitate to live our faith in the eyes of the public - or rather let us make it more personal, in the eyes of our neighbors, our coworkers, our teammates and our friends. This is part of the beauty of the great tradition taken up by so many parishes of the Corpus Christi procession, in which we walk with Our Lord beyond the walls of our church building and allow ourselves to be seen walking with Him. When our neighbors see us and later ask, "What was that all about," let us not miss the opportunity to "bear witness to our joyful faith in Christ the

Saviour."

**ANOTHER NEW BROTHER:** Recently, I alluded to the fact that we would have another new brother joining our parish family very soon. This weekend, we welcome **Devan Hornback**, as he receives Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion at the 10:30 Mass. Please congratulate him and keep him in your prayers.

**STEUBENVILLE CONFERENCE:** Next weekend, I will be with a group of 23 youth and 11 chaperones from our parish, as they experience a very special encounter with Jesus Christ at the Steubenville Youth Conference. Please keep them in your prayers, that their encounter with the Living God may inspire them to follow Him more closely and be bold witnesses of His saving truth and merciful love to their peers and to the world.

**FATHER HAAKE WELCOME AND DAILY MASS SCHEDULE:** On July 1st, we will welcome Fr. Chris Haake to our parish as our new parochial vicar (commonly known as "assistant" or "associate pastor"). He will be a great gift and blessing to our parish and I can't wait for you all to get to know him better. I am happy to share that this also means that, beginning in July, we will have **8 AM Mass every Friday**. We will have a smaller "soft welcome" at the Anniversary Mass and Breakfast, in honor of the 35th anniversary of the dedication of our church building, which conveniently is **July 2nd**, the day after he moves in. He will also join us just in time to help with the busiest week of the summer (and in some ways, of the whole year), Totus Tuus. I am so thankful that our children will be among the first who will have a chance to get to know him! At the end of that week, we will then have an official welcome celebration at a special Coffee and Donuts, hosted by the Welcome Committee on Sunday, **July 12th**. I hope that you can join us in welcoming him.

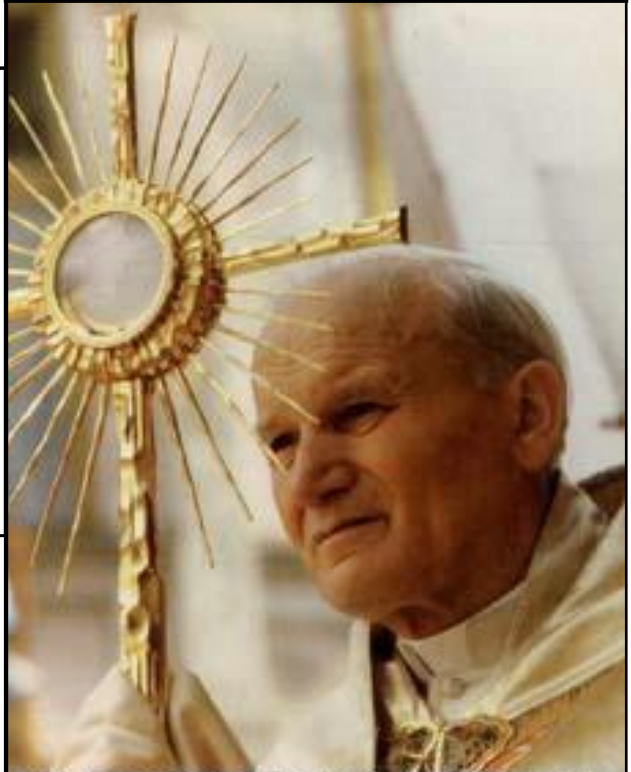

St. Malachy Parish has a monthly theme to collect items for the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry.

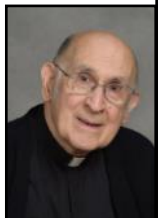

# The Man of the Shroud

**T**he Shroud of Turin has long been venerated by the faithful and is believed by many to be the burial cloth of Jesus of Nazareth. The Shroud is one of the most scientifically studied religious icons in history. As science has progressed, so has the speculation on how the image of the crucified man of the Shroud was made.

After decades of exhaustive and medical, historical and scientific research, the Center for the Study of the Passion of the Christ and the Holy Shroud has developed a moving and informative mobile exhibit on the Shroud of Turin. The centerpiece is a full length canvas replica of the Shroud made by the *Shroud of Turin Education and Research Association, Inc.* In addition, the mobile exhibit contains a large crucified corpus showing the wounds of Christ corresponding to the passion narrative in the Gospel accounts and the wounds shown on the Shroud.
