



## A message from our Parochial Vicar



Greetings from the rectory (where I am typing this message)!

to our 'neighbor' so that they too know

and experience the joy of the Holy Spirit. We also need 'neighbors' to do so for us.

"Good Samaritan" - a vessel of God's love.

These two messages go hand-in-hand: the Samaritan offered comfort to the "victim of the robbers". Of course, as the victim healed, most likely he became more and more filled with joy. As the Lord Jesus sent out the 72 to evangelize, heal, comfort, so we too are sent.

As an excellent teacher, Jesus takes questions and his more attracted to one or another and deepen our answers (if not always, most of the time) are a question: relationship with them, yet Christ invites, or rather, in the gospel lesson this Sunday "the Lord answers by reversing the question and showing through the account of the Good Samaritan that each one of us must make himself close to every person he meets: "Go and do likewise".

Loving, Jesus says, means acting like the Good Samaritan. And we know that he himself is the Good Samaritan par excellence; although he was God, he did not hesitate to humble himself to the point of becoming a man and giving his life for us. Love is therefore the "heart" of Christian life; indeed, love alone, awakened in us by the Holy Spirit, makes us Christ's witnesses." (Pope Benedict XVI, July 15, 2007)

The Holy Spirit dwells within us beginning at our Baptism, and the Christ the Lord states, "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses" (Acts 1: 8). Echoing Pope Benedict, we are witnesses to the Lord Jesus!

In a similar vein, "Let us ask [Jesus] to see and to have

compassion. This is a grace we need to ask of the Lord: "Lord, that I might see, that I might have compassion just like you see me and have compassion on me"" (Pope Francis, July 10. 2022).

Last Sunday I reflected upon Baptism Compassion which offers comfort helps spread the Joy (and discipleship) that brings us comfort of the Holy Spirit. With greater joy (not fleeting and joy (throughout our lifetime, and for happiness) we witness to the Lord Jesus! He shines eternity). We are called to offer comfort through us 'like a lamp on a lamp-stand for the whole house to see' (paraphrase of Matthew 5:19)

To witness to Jesus, we must allow His Spirit to continue to deepen our relationship with Him: I have been edified This Sunday we have the well-known parable of the and inspired to know, not only that our Pastor Father Gifford spends an hour in Eucharistic Adoration (daily), but also several of you are committed to Eucharistic Adoration. It is quality time spent with our Lord materially and spiritually present - Eucharist - that we become more and more the vessel of His Love to our "neighbor"; "that we make ourselves close to every person we meet". This does not discount the reality that we are exhorts us to love the one we are with!

> That will look different for each one of us, vet if it is 'charity' it is the Lord loving them through us. Why did Jesus give us the Eucharist? Because He loves us. Why does He love us? Because God is love! The Totus Tuus attendees know the answer to these two questions, just ask them.

> May we continue to embrace our discipleship with the Lord Jesus and open our hearts more and more to the prompting of His spirit dwelling within us, that we will be even more faithful vessels of Christ's love.



St. Malachy Parish has a monthly theme to collect items for the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry.




