

Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,



May, many of you were very generous in supporting our "Deacon Appreciation Month" through writing them notes of thanks and encouragement or donating toward their new diocesan vestments. In the process, the question arose: could we have a feature in the bulletin, helping us get to know the deacons better? Great idea! Let's get to know them better. We will feature two each week for the next three weeks:

#### Dcn. Art Ries:

Art Ries was ordained a deacon on May 19, 2007. But, he has been a parishioner since 2001. He and his wife Cindy have three sons. Rob and his wife Michelle are parishioners at the newly merged Divine


