A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"Blessed are they who have kept the word with a generous heart and yield a harvest through perseverance." (Gospel Acclamation for this Sunday). This past

May, many of you were very generous in supporting our "Deacon Appreciation Month" through writing them notes of thanks and encouragement or donating toward their new diocesan vestments. In the process, the question arose: could we have a feature in the bulletin, helping us get to know the deacons better? Great idea! Let's get to know them better. We will feature two each week for the next three weeks:

Dcn. Art Ries:

Art Ries was ordained a deacon on May 19, 2007. But, he has been a parishioner since 2001. He and his wife Cindy have three sons. Rob and his wife Michelle are parishioners at the newly merged Divine Mercy Parish and attend church at St. Patrick's in Colona. Darin and his wife Molly are parishioners at the Cathedral of St. Mary in Fargo, North Dakota. Jim and his wife Martha are St. Malachy parishioners. We also have 14 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren. What is his favorite part about being a deacon? "It has been rewarding to help people during times of sadness, questioning or uncertainty through divorce care and annulment process, or through bereavement ministry. I also really enjoyed my 12 years involved in Cursillo." His favorite scripture passage is Psalm 63: "O God, you are my God—it is you I seek! For you my body yearns; for you my soul thirsts, In a land parched, lifeless, and without water." "It describes my desire for a closeness with God." His favorite saint is St. Therese of Lisieux "because of her little way of serving God."



Dcn. Tom Wachtel:

Tom Wachtel was ordained a deacon on May 9, 1992, but has been a parishioner, "All of my life. My parents and all of my Grandparents were Baptized here. My father is James R. Wachtel (d) son of Emma and Jack Wachtel. My mother is Virginia Mary (Vandemore) (d) daughter of Margaret (Andrews) (d) and Aloysius (Ollie) Vandemore (d). I have four brothers Robert married to Mary (Foster) who lives in Geneseo, and three other brothers Mike, Tim and Jeff who all live at a distance. My wife is Alana (Bottorff) (d. 2023). My Children and grandchildren are Jamie (Aubrey), Champaign Illinois, Aaron Thomas (Pamela) of Geneseo (Lucy 2008, Charlize 2010, Frederick 2012 and Felix 2016), Catherine (Jim) Kikos of Joliet, IL. "He had an incredible thirst for knowledge and quest for understanding but all through his life to his dying moment realized the true goal was to personally unite with God."

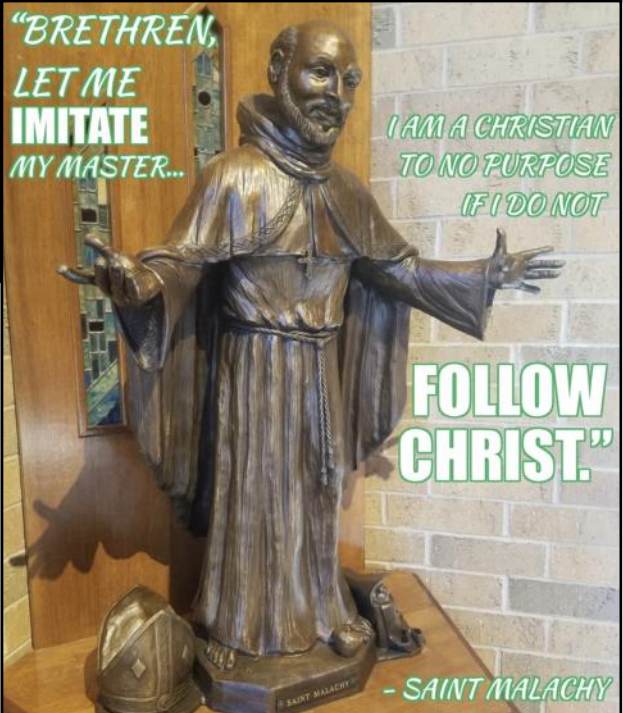

the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry.

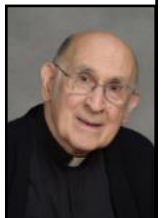
The theme for July is:

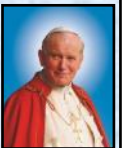
