

A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

Last week, we began a three week process of getting to better know our deacons, prompted by a request from a parishioner, at the time of our recent "Deacon Appreciation Month." Let's get to

know a couple more.

Dcn. Tom Mattan:



Tom Mattan was ordained by Bishop Lou on December 3, 2022. But, he has been a parishioner for 55 years. "My family moved to Geneseo in 1970. I am the oldest of 8 children of Dick and Joyce Mattan. I have been married to my wonderful wife Debbie for 42

years. We have 3 grown sons, 4 grandchildren and 1 more on the way... I am honored and humbled to be able to administer some of the Sacraments of the Church. But I think my favorite part of being a deacon is serving at Mass, especially the holidays: Christmas, Easter, Holy Thursday, Corpus Christi, those special Masses." The Letter of James is his favorite book of the bible and he especially identified James 2:14-18. "What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him? If a brother or sister has nothing to wear and has no food for the day, and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, keep warm, and eat well," but you do not give them the necessities of the body, what good is it? So also faith of itself, if it does not have works, is dead. Indeed someone may say, "You have faith and I have works," Demonstrate your faith to me without works, and I will demonstrate my faith to you from my works." "James is full of true wisdom and the need to care for the poor. It is presented in a very straightforward and practical way." Saint Joseph is his favorite saint. "He inspires me to work hard, to love my family and to guietly do the will of God as best I can."

Dcn. Robert O'Rourke:



Robert O'Rourke was ordained a deacon by Bishop Jenky on May 19, 2007 with Class VIII. But, he has been a parishioner since "the fall of 1986, 39 years ago... I am married to Kathryn Theresa and we will celebrate our 53rd wedding

anniversary this July. We have two sons, Seann and Brendan." His favorite part about being a deacon is "sharing my deacon ministry with Kathy... We share our prayers, scripture thoughts, taking the Eucharist to others, and our growth in knowing and trusting Jesus. I also look forward to each time I enter the sacred space of the Sanctuary and near the Altar during Mass. The presence of Jesus is profound with the Eucharist, the large Crucifix, the words of God being proclaimed, and knowing we are at Calvary." His favorite Scripture passage is John 18:37-38. "Pilate asked him, "So you are a king? Jesus answered, "You say that I am a king. For this I was born, and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice." Pilate asked him, "What is truth?" The truth was standing right in front of Pilate and he did not see or hear the truth of Jesus as he was caught up in his own world. The passage reminds me to recognize Jesus in my life and to receive his truth." His favorite saint is Saint Patrick. "He was the first Saint that I was introduced to when growing up. Christmas, Easter, and St. Patrick's Day were high on our list to celebrate. I have read and studied about his life and the influence he had to bring the Catholic faith to Ireland and other European countries. My great grandparents left Ireland in the mid 1800's to begin a new life in America. They traveled with an Irish priest who helped them to find land and a home in central Illinois."

PRAYING FOR YOU FROM KNOCK: This Sunday, I am praying for you all from Knock Shrine, Ireland's International Eucharistic and Marian Shrine, along with 10 of our fellow parishioners and 15 other pilgrims from Ohio and Pennsylvania. We look forward to

returning to be with you all next weekend.
