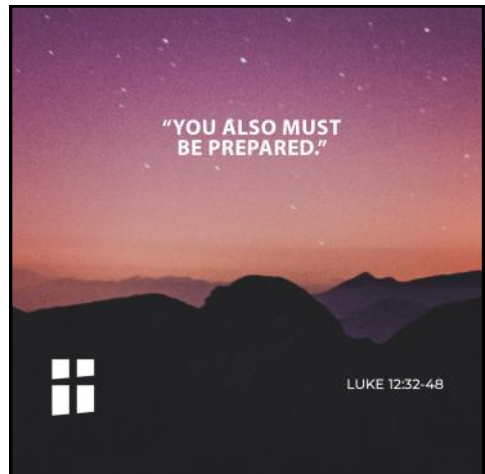

A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

This week, let us conclude our three week process of getting to better know our deacons, prompted by a question from a parishioner during our Deacon Appreciation Month in May.

Dcn. Mike Sigwalt:



Mike Sigwalt was ordained May of 2017, but he and his wife Barbara have been parishioners since 1984. In addition to Barbara, "Andrew is my eldest son. Thomas is my youngest son. Arline is my mother." Asked about his favorite part about being a deacon,

Mike answered, "The concept of service is probably my favorite part. My work at the Food Pantry feels like an extension, of sorts, of my duties. I realize this occurs apart from the parish, but the work at the Pantry would seem to really be representative of "service." Within the parish setting, homiletics are probably my favorite part." He found the question of his favorite Scripture passage, "a somewhat surprisingly hard question, since it's hard for me to narrow it down to just one? Probably these two: The Beatitudes (Matthew 5:3-12 and Luke 6:20-26) and Matthew 25:31-40 ("I was hungry and you gave me food . . ."). And regarding his favorite saint, "I've always been fond of St. Isadore due to his rural and agricultural connections. I'm also very fond of St. Teresa of Kolkata, St. Nicolas and St. Francis for their connections with the poor." Finally, although he is not canonized, Mike also wanted to mention Pope "Leo XIII for his connections with Catholic Social Thought."

Dcn. Bob Thoene:



Bob Thoene was ordained a deacon on December 3, 2022. But he has been a parishioner since "around 19 years. Sometime just before Andrew entered Kindergarten with Mrs. Goethals

as his teacher." His wife, "Shauna (Hart) Thoene, (is) working on getting her Master's degree in the next year from Benedictine College." Their sons are, "Andrew, senior at Benedictine College in Atchison Kansas, Micah, junior at Benedictine College in Atchison Kansas and Joey, junior at Geneseo High School." His favorite part about being a deacon is "Being so close to Jesus during Mass, especially when heaven comes down with the Holy Spirit during the Epiclesis and during the consecration/transubstantiation of the bread and wine into the body, blood, soul and Divinity of Jesus." He also mentions, "Baptisms as this is the first Sacrament that brings us into the faith as Christians and opens the other Sacraments of the Catholic Church. And it is so awesome when they are so tiny and precious little babies!" He shared some of his favorite Scripture passages: "Ephesians 6:9-18: Put on the full Armor of God. We need to seek God's grace and protection from the wickedness and snares of the devil." He also mentioned Mathew 22:37-39, which "basically summarizes and categorizes the 10 Commandments and simplifies them to two. Love God the Father and love your neighbor. I also put this Scripture on the back of the Oasis shirts. Love God and love others." Finally, he is also a fan of Matthew 18:1-5, "We are all called to have the faith of children, that pure and unconditional trust in the Father." He also is inspired by St. Michael the Archangel, "because he is a warrior for God and is my Confirmation Saint when I converted and joined the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil Mass in 2001." And last but not never least, Dcn. Bob also has a love of Saint Joseph, "because he was the protector & provider for his family, Jesus and Mary. Terror of demons."

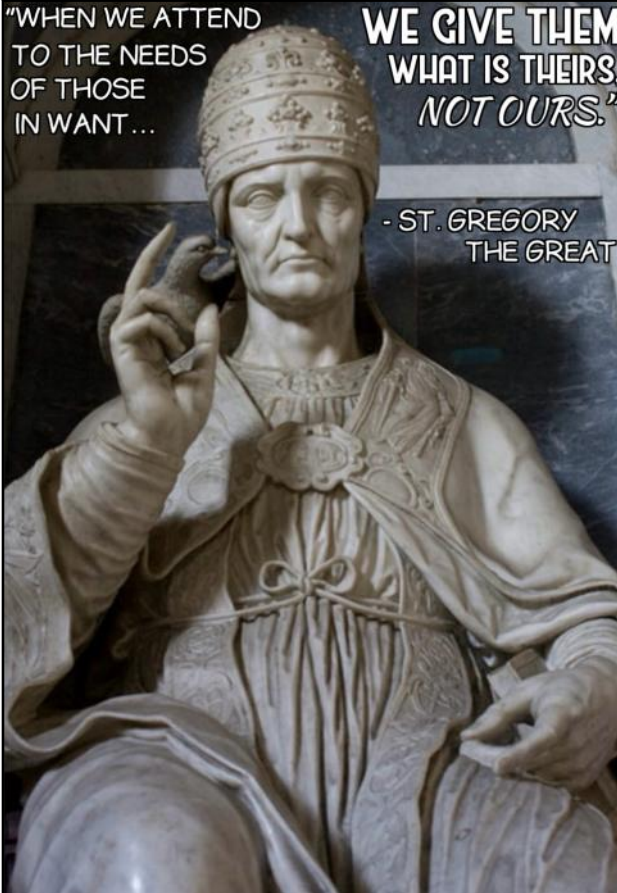

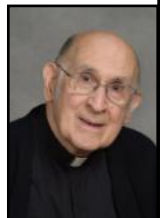
