

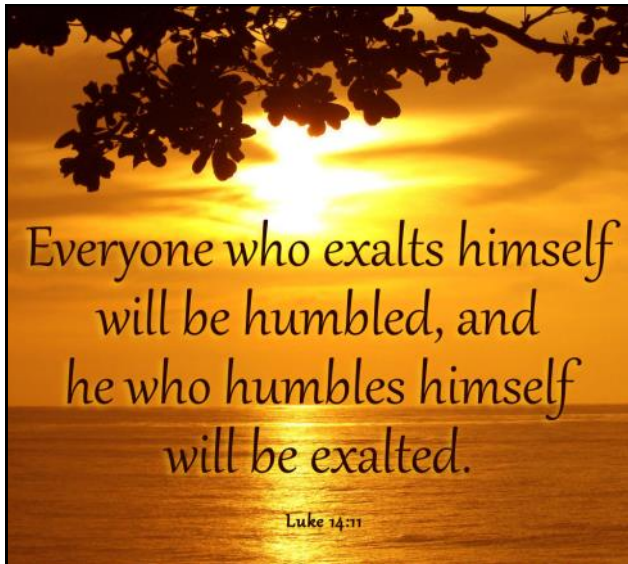

A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"We learn to pray by praying." It all began with this simple quote from Saint Mother Teresa of Calcutta. I had shared a short video of her with our school children, while teaching them about her. This simple quote from that

video was so simple, beautiful and important that I knew it wouldn't be the last time we used it. First, I shared it with our CCD children, who had been working so hard to learn their prayers, filling their beautiful garden with flowers (you may recall this being on display in the narthex last spring). As I continued to ponder my own desire that this quote would continue to accompany us for a while, and to wonder if it was the Lord's desire as well, I noticed that it could be easily reworked into a "call and answer" question: *How do we learn to pray? By praying!*



By this time, our Principal Mrs. Devon Schaaf and our teachers and I had begun discerning a plan and a focus for the next school year (aka "discipleship year"). Out of this discernment, a desire and a call to focus on virtue was arising. All of the virtues are ordered toward love. We make good choices, to build good habits that will form our character, all that we may readily, easily and naturally love as God made us to love. Thus, the second question became apparent: *How do we learn to love? By loving!*


Prayer and virtue might be called the basics of discipleship, the basic response of a disciple to the call of the

Lord and of His Love. There can be times and seasons when the heart feels drawn to go back to the basics, whether the heart of an individual or of a community. As the Eucharistic Revival was drawing to a close, the Universal Church began celebrating a Jubilee Year of Hope and our Diocese began celebrating its own 150th Anniversary, my heart was feeling this draw. And the developments described above made me wonder if it wasn't, in fact, the *heart of our parish* that was receiving this call. In the weeks and months to come, I look forward to continuing to unpack this theme and discussing the various ways that you can go deeper in allowing prayer and virtue to enrich your own life. *"If anyone loves righteousness, [Wisdom's] labors are virtues; for she teaches temperance and prudence, justice, and courage" (Wisdom 8:7).*

PARISH FINANCES: In this bulletin, you can see a more detailed reporting on our Parish Finances for the previous fiscal year, which we recently completed on June 30. At the request of both Parish Council and Finance Council, I will be addressing our parish finances from the pulpit next weekend. I am very grateful to all of our parishioners for the generous stewardship of time, talent and treasure that helped us to finish this year with a positive balance yet again. Thanks to the guidance of our Finance Council and the diligence of our parish staff, we have also been able to remain under budget on expenses and to maintain our assets. Still, we look forward to a new year with new challenges. I am confident that we can meet these challenges, with all of your help. Thank you for all of the ways that you support and participate in the mission of making disciples here at Saint Malachy Parish!

ANNUAL DIOCESAN APPEAL: Next weekend is also the kick-off of the Annual Diocesan Appeal. As we look back at last year's appeal, I am thankful to all who supported this important effort and helped us work toward our goal. With your help, we increased our giving and came closer to our goal than the previous year, as well as remaining within a range that will not deplete our ADA Reserve account. Thank you! As we look toward this year's appeal, we have a goal of \$104,922, which is an increase of 2.5% from last year. You should receive materials from the diocese soon. Thank you for supporting this appeal, which benefits the whole Diocese of Peoria, including ourselves!
