





A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"If anyone loves righteousness, [Wisdom's] labors are virtues; for she teaches temperance and prudence, justice, and courage" (Wisdom 8:7). These words serve as the theme verse for our "Back to the

Basics" year, focused on prayer and virtue. Last week, our focus was drawn to that virtue which the catechism describes as "the foundation of prayer" (CCC 2559): humility.

Yet again, we heard a beautiful homily on that Gospel from one of our deacons. Among other things, Deacon Robert reflected on how the lessons on humility at the table in the house of the Pharisee point us to the example of humility that Jesus Himself offers us in the Holy Eucharist. Also yet again, the words of our deacon resonated with words I had recently read from a successor of Saint Peter. This week, it is the words of Saint John Paul II that I would like to share with you as a resonance with and elaboration upon the words we heard in our homily last weekend.

"The Sacrifice of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ offered up for us is an act of supreme love on the part of the Saviour. It is his great victory over sin and death—a victory that he communicates to us. The Eucharist is a promise of eternal life, since Jesus himself tells us: "He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day" (Jn 6:54). The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is meant to be the festive celebration of our salvation. In the Mass we give thanks and praise to God our Father for having given us Redemption through the precious blood of Jesus Christ... The Mass is indeed the source and summit of your Christian life... Yes, it is from the Eucharist that all of us receive the grace and strength for daily living to live real Christian lives, in the joy of knowing that God loves us, that Christ died for us, and that the Holy Spirit lives in us... no matter what our occupation is—the Eucharist is a challenge to our daily lives... The Eucharist is also a great call to conversion... If we receive it as such a call, such an invitation, it brings forth in us its proper fruits. It transforms our lives." (Homily

in Phoenix Park, Dublin, 29 September 1979).

Let us ask Saint John Paul II, Saint Malachy and all the saints to pray for us that we may be transformed by our encounter with Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist, in order that we may grow in humility and all of the virtues.

ADA KICK-OFF: Thank you in advance for your support of this Annual Diocesan Appeal for 2025, which officially begins this weekend. With your help, we can reach and exceed our goal of \$104,922. Thank you for supporting this appeal, which benefits the whole Diocese of Peoria, including ourselves!

STAINED GLASS WINDOWS: I am happy to offer an update about the arrival of our stained glass windows. September 22 through September 26, Rigali Studios will be here to do some prep work. They will return the following week to install the windows. This will involve scaffolds set up in the church throughout both weeks, including the weekend in between, which will temporarily limit our seating. I will share more about this significant moment for our parish in the weeks to come.

YOUTH ADORATION AND CHILDREN'S MASS:

Next week, we return to our beloved custom of the Sunday Children's Mass on the second Sunday of the month. Additionally, we will have our first experience of a new custom. On most of these second Sundays, we will also host a short time of Youth Adoration in the church from 10:15 to 10:25. This is designed to give our middle school students preparing for Confirmation the experience of guiet prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament during their class time. This has been fruitful for our students in the past and we are excited to begin this new approach of making it available to our current students. You are most welcome to join our students for prayer in the church during this time. We welcome you to join us in maintaining a quiet and reverent environment, which I recently explained to our younger students, helps us to be able to hear the Lord who revealed to the prophet Elijah that He often speaks to us in whispers.
