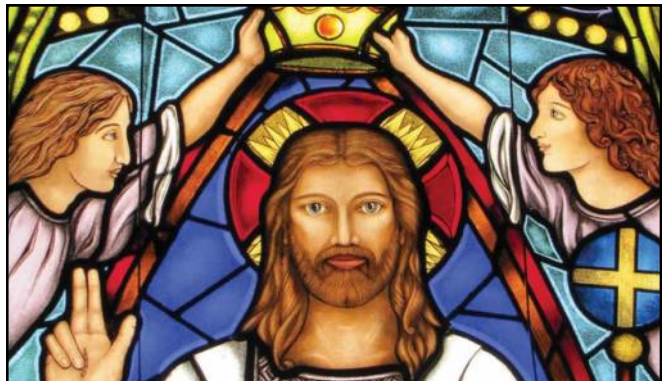

A Letter from the Pastor



Dear St. Malachy Parishioners,

"If anyone loves righteousness, [Wisdom's] labors are virtues; for she teaches temperance and prudence, justice, and courage" (Wisdom 8:7). These words

have quietly served as a theme verse for our focus this year on going Back to the Basics, by focusing on Prayer and Virtue. I have included them at the end of each bulletin letter. But, I haven't yet written about them. Now seems like as good a time as any to begin!

The Wisdom of Solomon was not his own. It was given to him from the Lord, when he humbled himself to recognize that he did not have the wisdom to lead in the manner in which he was called to lead. So, he turned to the source of Wisdom and he asked for the Wisdom that he needed. God granted him the Wisdom that inspired an entire genre of literature, within the Sacred Scriptures. Wisdom Literature stands as a tribute to the God who made the human mind and heart to know and love Him. Specifically, the Book of Wisdom, which has shown up in our Daily Mass Lectionary this past week, represents God's desire that we would know Him and humanity's desire for the Wisdom that comes from Him alone. *"God gives Wisdom to those in whom He finds the right dispositions. A person with this gift is able to see that Divine Wisdom rules the entire universe, guides man to act uprightly in this present life, and bolsters his hope of a life to come"* (from the commentary of *The Navarre Bible: Wisdom Books*).

It is in the pages of this often overlooked book of Sacred Scripture that we find the four Cardinal Virtues: prudence, temperance, justice and fortitude (also known as courage). These words are quoted in the Catechism of the Catholic Church: *"Human virtues are firm attitudes, stable dispositions, habitual perfections of intellect and will that govern our actions, order our passions, and guide our conduct according to reason and faith. They make possible ease, self-mastery, and*

joy in leading a morally good life. The virtuous man is he who freely practices the good. The moral virtues are acquired by human effort. They are the fruit and seed of morally good acts; they dispose all the powers of the human being for communion with divine love. Four virtues play a pivotal role and accordingly are called "cardinal"; all the others are grouped around them. They are: prudence, justice, fortitude, and temperance. "If anyone loves righteousness, [Wisdom's] labors are virtues; for she teaches temperance and prudence, justice, and courage." These virtues are praised under other names in many passages of Scripture" (The Virtues, CCC 1804-1805). May each and every one of us keep learning every day how to pray by praying and how to love by loving, one good choice at a time.

OUR JOURNEY WITH HALLOW: We are reaching the end of the How to Pray Challenge, through Hallow. I hope you have had the opportunity to participate. If you have not, or if you have gotten behind, it should remain available for roughly another week, but you may have to listen to multiple sessions in one day, depending on the progress you have already made. It has certainly been a blessing. Also, please remember that we have been using a Parish Partnership *Trial*. Therefore, our parish page may no longer be available in the near future. You can continue to access the same materials on Hallow, which you have already enjoyed, according to the account that you have (paid or free). Hallow also allows you to continue to exchange prayer requests with your "Friends." I hope this has been helpful for you in deepening your life of daily prayer.

St. Malachy Parish has a monthly theme to collect items for the Geneseo-Atkinson Food Pantry.

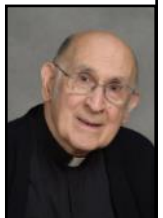
The theme for **November** is:
