- ◆ ADA 2018 still discussing with Diocese- get a \$40% break because of the school, but if we pay more than 50% toward school, we get 50% break. So working on that.
- ◆ Cluster Parishes Will continue to send information about our parish to them for their bulletins and continue to publish their information in our bulletins. We will do the little things for now so that we are aware of each other.
- ◆ WinterFest 2018 even with the unfavorable weather, it was considered a success. Made around \$13,000 or 14,000. Next year? No volunteers yet.
- ◆ Liturgy Committee Had specific request– Holy Thursday would like 3 council members to be Gift Bearers at Mass Susan, Mark & Shannon volunteered. Chuck will lector. Then had a general request They are getting older and looking for help in general during the Triduum. Could P.C. Members help as a group or individually?
